PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSE

Justin Herbert, Fr., QB, ORE

Tied the Oregon single-game individual record with 489 passing yards while completing 31 of 42 passes for four TDs and no interceptions. Became the school's first player to ever accumulate 500 yards of total offense, finishing with 512 in only his third career start. Led the Ducks to scoring drives on their first five possessions (TDs on the first two) while throwing for 320 yards (20-24) in the first half.

DEFENSE

Azeem Victor, Jr., LB, WASH

Victor earned Walter Camp National Defensive Player of the Week honors after compiling a total of 16 tackles (10 solo, six assists) in the No. 4-ranked Huskies' 31-24 win at then-No. 17 Utah. The 16 tackles were the most by a Husky player since the 2012 Fight Hunger Bowl win over BYU.

SPECIAL TEAMS

Dante Pettis, Jr., WR/PR, WASH

Broke the Washington school record with the fifth punt return for a touchdown in his career Saturday as the No. 4 Huskies held off No. 17 Utah, 31-24. With the score tied at 24-24 with just 3:25 remaining in the game, Pettis provided the winning score with his 58-yard return, his second of the season. Pettis also had two receptions for 13 yards in the win.

QUICK HITS

- WASHINGTON and WASHINGTON STATE are both 5-0 in league play for the first time since 1997 when both teams started league play at 5-0 ... Huskies and Cougars both ranked in AP Top 25 in the same week for the first time since Sept. 28, 2003.

The Pac-12 posted has posted a winning record outside league for 31 consecutive seasons . . . The Pac-12 recorded a 35-12 record in non-conference action last season, and is 72-21 in non-conference play the last two seasons.

AROUND THE PAC-12

DIVISION CHAMPIONS: With WASHINGTON (5-0) and WASHINGTON STATE (5-0) the lone remaining teams undefeated in Pac-12 play, it's worth noting that no team has come through Conference play unscathed since the league expanded to 12 teams. In four of the previous five seasons of Pac-12 play, the North Division champion finished Conference play with one loss. Only the 2013 season produced a North Division champion with more than one loss when Oregon and Stanford each finished tied at 7-2. While in the South Division, only once did the South Division produce a champion with less than two losses when ARIZONA STATE finished 8-1 in 2013.

POLL NOTES: WASHINGTON is the eighth different Pac-12 team to appear in the AP Top 10 over the last three seasons. Washington has been in the AP Top 10 for nine consecutive weeks, the longest stretch since it appeared in the last nine ranking periods during the 2000 season ... STANFORD dropped from the Top 25 on Oct. 10, ending a streak of 19 consecutive weeks in the poll. It also marked the first time that either OREGON, Stanford or USC has not been ranked in the AP Top 25 since Nov. 21, 1999. That was also the last time the Conference did not have a team ranked in the AP Top 25 ... On Oct. 2, COLORADO (No. 21) made its first appearance in the AP poll since 2005. It was the highest ranking for the Buffs since they were No. 17 the week of Sept. 7, 2003 ... WASHINGTON STATE returns to the polls for the first time since Nov. 22, 2015 (No. 20).

ON THE RUN: For the second straight week, seven Pac-12 running backs each rushed for 100 or more yards, led by USC sophomore **Ronald Jones II** who had 223 yards on 18 carries (12.4 avg) in the win over California. UTAH senior RB **Joe Williams** rushed for 172 yards in the loss to Washington and has rushed for 683 yards over the last three game and 758 yards (151.6 per game/6.3 avg per carry) for the season. But since he has only played in five of his team's nine games, he does not qualify for the league's statistical rankings. Only two other Pac-12 running backs have rushed for more yards than Williams this season - WASHINGTON'S **Myles Gaskin** (8 games - 878 yards/109.8 per game) and STANFORD'S **Christian McCaffrey** (7 games - 781 yards/111.6 per game).

REVOLVING QUARTERBACKS: A total of 22 different quarterbacks have started this season, led by ARIZONA and ARIZONA STATE with three each. Only CALIFORNIA, UTAH, WASHINGTON and WASHINGTON STATE has started the same signal-caller for each of their games this season.

PUNT, PASS & KICK: UTAH junior P **Mitch Wishnowsky** leads the FBS in punting with a 48.8 average and has twice been named the national Ray Guy Punter of the Week. He's placed 24 of his 44 punts inside the 20, and has not had a touchback since the first game of the season ... Five Pac-12 quarterbacks are ranked among the FBS Top 25 in passing efficiency - No. 2 **Jake Browning**, WASHINGTON (195.6), No. 7 **Sam Darnold**, USC (173.1), No. 13 **Sefo Liufau**, COLORADO (157.9), No. 17 **Luke Falk**, WASHINGTON STATE (152.5) and No. 19 **Steven Montez**, COLORADO (151.4) ... ARIZONA STATE senior PK **Zane Gonzalez**, the FBS career record holder with 93 career field goals, is second in the FBS in field goals per game (2.22). CALIFORNIA'S **Matt Anderson** is No. 9 (1.75 field goals per game), while UTAH'S **Andy Phillips** is No. 23 (1.56 per game).

THE SCHEDULE: The non-conference schedules include 18 opponents that participated in a bowl game last season. In all, 11 Pac-12 teams will face a team that appeared in a bowl game last season with USC facing three such opponents ... The Pac-12 posted a 35-12 record in non-conference play in 2015 and is 72-21 in non-league action over the previous two seasons ... Each Conference team will play a nine-game league schedule that includes five games within its own division and four games in the other division. Teams with the best record in their respective divisions will meet in the Pac-12 title game on Friday, Dec. 2 (FOX) at Levi's Stadium in Santa Clara, Calif.

PAC-12 SUCCESS IN RIO... OREGON WR/KR **Devon Allen** represented Team USA at the Rio Olympics in the 110m hurdles where he finished fifth ... USC CB/WR/KR **Adoree' Jackson** (long jump) and ARIZONA STATE WR/KR **Tim White** (triple jump) attempted to make the USA squad, but came up short ... Former Cal running back Jahvid Best (100m) represented St. Lucia ... If the Pac-12 was considered a country, it's student-athletes, both current and former, would have placed fifth in the medal count at the Rio Olympics:

THIS WEEK'S GAMES

UCLA at COLORADO

Thurs., Nov. 3 • 7:00 p.m. PT • FS1

UCLA: UCLA has posted a 13-9 overall record against ranked opponents under Coach Mora and has won seven of the last 10 ... The Bruins have lost five games this season by a total of 32 points (6.4 avg. margin). In each of those games, they have had the ball with a final possession and a chance to tie or take the lead. The biggest margin was 9 points to Stanford after the Cardinal returned a Josh Rosen fumble for a touchdown on the final play of the game ... DE **Takkarist McKinley** ranks first in the nation in tackles for loss/g (2.0) and has 13.0 tackles for loss in the last six contests.

COLORADO: Is 6-2 overall for the first time since the 2005 season (when CU opened 7-2) ... The Buffs are bowl eligible for the first time since 2007 ... Colorado is the only Pac-12 school to have both their offense and defense ranked in the nation's top 25 in yardage and yardage allowed. Those teams are Alabama (No. 17 offense, No. 4 defense), Louisville (1/10), Ohio State (20/6), Baylor (4/25), Colorado (19/12) and Southern Miss (22/16) ... In four games in Colorado this season (three in Boulder and one in Denver), Colorado has outscored opponents 187-36.

LAST MEETING (Oct. 31, 2015): The Bruins held on for a 35-31 victory despite allowing Colorado to run 114 plays to amass 554 total yards and hold the ball for more than 41 minutes. UCLA's Josh Rosen was 19-of-33 for 262 yards and a TD for the Bruins and had 407 yards of total offense. Paul Perkins rushed for 118 yards and added two scores. Colorado's Sefo Liufau was 37-of-58 for 312 yards.

OREGON STATE at STANFORD

Sat., Nov. 5 • 12:30 p.m. PT • FS1

OREGON STATE: Tough schedule for the Beavers. Through week nine, each of the seven opponents that has defeated Oregon State this season is now bowl eligible ... Sophomore RB **Ryan Nall's** 89-yard TD run in the first quarter was the third-longest in school history. Nall gained 131 yards on 19 carries. It was his second 100-yard game this season. Nall added 71 receiving yards on three catches to tally 203 all-purpose yards ... Senior WR **Victor Bolden Jr.** had seven receptions for 113 yards and now has a least one reception in 32 consecutive games. His 158 career receptions are good for seventh all-time at OSU ... Junior PK **Garrett Owens** has a streak of 63 successful PATs (17-for-17 as a freshman, 23-for-23 as a sophomore and 23-for-23 this season).

STANFORD: Junior RB **Christian McCaffrey** (169) and sophomore RB **Bryce Love** (78) combined for 247 rushing yards in the 34-10 win at Arizona ... Senior P **Conrad Ukropina** converted four extra points attempts to increase his school-record to 88 in a row ... The Cardinal defense has allowed just one touchdown in each of the last three games. Stanford has allowed 13 or fewer points in six of eight games this season. It is currently 18th in the FBS in scoring defense (19.0 ppg).

LAST MEETING (Sept. 25, 2015): No. 21 Stanford cruised to a 42-24 victory over Oregon State behind Christian McCaffrey's career-high 206 yards rushing. He ended up with 303 all-purpose yards. Kevin Hogan, a game-time decision, completed nine of 14 passes for 163 yards and two TDs. Oregon State's Seth Collins threw for 275 yards, including a 40-yard scoring pass to Jordan Villamin to open the fourth quarter, pulling the Beavers within 35-24, but Stanford answered with Barry Sanders' 65-yard touchdown run and Oregon State couldn't catch up.

ARIZONA at WASHINGTON STATE

Sat., Nov. 5 • 1 p.m. PT • PAC12/PACAZ/PACWA

ARIZONA: Senior WR **Nate Phillips** extended his streak of consecutive games with a reception to 41 games. It's the fifth longest active streak in the nation ... The Wildcats totaled seven tackles-for-loss Saturday, the most Arizona has posted against a conference opponent this season and now have produced at least two TFLs in 70 straight games ... Arizona allowed just 104 passing yards against Stanford, marking the second lowest passing output by a Conference opponent in coach Rich Rodriguez's tenure at Arizona.

WASHINGTON STATE: The Cougars move to 5-0 in Pac-12 play for the first time since 2002, as well as their first six-game winning streak since 2003. WSU looks to move to 6-0 in league play for the first time since 1930 ... Senior WR **Gabe Marks** has 283 career receptions (2nd all-time in Pac-12 behind CU's Nelson Spruce - 294, 2012-15) and 3,113 receiving yards (2nd most in WSU history behind Marquies Wilson - 3,207, 2010-12) ... Senior WR **River Cracraft** has a reception in 37 straight games ... Cracraft and Marks are the only pair of Pac-12 teammates in league history to each have 200 receptions at the same time ... Junior QB **Luke Falk** completed 33 of 46 pass attempts for 415 yards and 5 TDs. It was his 10th career 400-yard game. He upped his career passing yards to 9,351, and career TD passes to 75, both third in WSU history ... Junior RB **Jamal Morrow** has been game captain 17 straight games, he's now 7-1 in coin tosses.

LAST MEETING (Oct. 24, 2015): Washington State quarterback Luke Falk completed 47 of 62 passes for 514 yards and five touchdowns to lead the Cougars to a 45-42 victory in Tucson. He had 335 yards and four scores by halftime. Arizona quarterback Jerrard Randall accounted for 242 yards (137 passing, 105 rushing) of total offense and added two TDs.

OREGON at USC

Sat., Nov. 5 • 4 p.m. PT • ESPN

OREGON: Over the last two games, freshman QB **Justin Herbert** has completed in 53-of-82 passes for 747 yards and 10 TDs with just one interception. Herbert's 10 touchdowns over the past two games matches the UO record set by Marcus Mariota in 2012 ... Senior TE **Pharaoh Brown** had seven receptions for 129 yards and 2 TDs in the win over Arizona State. Entering the game, he had 15 receptions for 174 yards for the season ... Junior PK **Aidan Schneider** has a made a string of 102 consecutive PATs ... Oregon avoided losing six straight for the first time since 1991.

USC: The Trojans were perfect in October and are riding a four-game winning streak ... Freshman QB **Sam Darnold** completed 18-of-25 passes for 231 yards and 5 TDs in the win over California. He also threw five TDs in the previous game vs. at Arizona to become the first Trojan QB to throw 5 scores in back-to-back games. He is 104-of-153 (.680) for 1,379 yards with 16 TDs and just two interceptions in five starts ... The Trojans ran for 398 yards vs. Cal, their most since getting 430 against UCLA in 2005 ... Junior WR **JuJu Smith-Schuster** has a reception in all 35 games in which he has played ... Junior CB-WR-RET **Adoree' Jackson** had 2 kickoff returns for 56 yards and with his total of 1,779 yards became USC's career kickoff return yardage leader breaking the previous mark of 1,723 yards held by Curtis Conway.

LAST MEETING (Nov. 21, 2015): Oregon QB Vernon Adams Jr. threw a USC opponent record 6 TDs as No. 23 Oregon defeated the No. 22 Trojans, 48-28. Adams completed 20-of-25 for 407 yards and threw his TDs to 6 different receivers. Royce Freeman rushed for 147 yards as Oregon had 578 total yards. USC had 424 total yards behind Cody Kessler's 30-of-41 passing for 238 yards and 2 TDs.

WASHINGTON at CALIFORNIA

Sat., Nov. 5 • 7:30 p.m. PT • ESPN

WASHINGTON: Winning streak is at 11 in a row, tied for the second-longest current streak in FBS. It's the Huskies longest streak since winning 12 straight from 2000-01 ... Over the last 11 games, sophomore QB **Jake Browning** has completed 185-of-256 (.733) for 2,593 yards, 32 TDs and 4 interceptions. Browning's 27 TD passes this season are third most in single-season history (Keith Price had 33 in 2011; Cody Pickett had 28 in 2002) ... UW leads the FBS in turnover margin (+1.63, 19 turnovers gained and 5 lost) ... Washington has a 107-7 first quarter scoring advantage and is outscoring opponents 214-34 in the first half.

CALIFORNIA: Senior QB **Davis Webb** completed 34-of-53 passes for 333 yards and two TDs, plus one rushing TD at USC. He now has 29 TD passes, which moves him up to fourth on the school's single-season list (Pat Barnes is third with 31 in 1996) ... Webb's rushing TD gives him five on the year, which are the most for a Cal QB in a season since Joe Ayoub had five in 2005. Aaron Rodgers also had five in both 2003 and 2004 ... Senior RB **Khalfani Muhammad** picked up 159 all-purpose yards (89 rush/70 return) and now has 4,154 career all-purpose yardage. That ranks fifth all-time, behind No. 4. Chuck Muncie, who had 4,194 all-purpose yards from 1973-75.

LAST MEETING (Oct. 3, 2015): California forced five turnovers en route to a gritty 30-24 win over the Huskies. Jared Goff completed 24-of-40 passes for 342 yards and two TDs and one interception. Kenny Lawler set season highs with seven receptions and 112 yards while also scoring once. The Huskies gained just 259 yards of offense as Cal dominated time of possession to the tune of 39:49 to 20:11. In addition to five turnovers, Cal posted five sacks.

OPEN DATE

ARIZONA STATE: With three rushing TDs in ASU's 35-54 loss to Oregon, the Sun Devils now have 24 rushing TDs total this season after having only 19 all of last season ... Junior RB **Kalen Ballage** has 12 rushing TDs this season. He is just the fourth Sun Devil since 2000 to have double-digit rushing TDs in a single season ... **Dillon Sterling-Cole** became just the fifth Sun Devil to start a game as a true freshman at quarterback joining John Walker (1984), Bret Powers (1990), Jake Plummer (1993) and Brock Osweiler (2009). Sterling-Cole finished 21-of-38 for 302 yards and 1 TD.

UTAH: Senior RB **Joe Williams** rushed for over 100 yards for the third time this season (fifth time in his career) with 172 yards on 35 carries. Williams is averaging 227.7 yards per game since un-retiring (three games) ... Sophomore P **Mitch Wishnowsky** averaged 53.7 yards on six punts against Washington. He downed four of his six punts inside the 20-yard line, including two inside the 10-yard line (7 and 8-yard lines) ... Utah's attendance of 47,801 was the second-largest in school history.

If the Pac-12 champion is in the top four of the College Football Playoff poll following the 2016 season it would vacate its spot in the Rose Bowl to participate in the CFP semi-finals in either the Chick-fil-A Peach or Fiesta Bowl. The Rose Bowl would then fill the vacated spot with another Pac-12 team.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS

The winner of each Division will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
6. Highest ranking by SportSource Analytics following the last weekend of regular-season games.
7. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest ranking by SportSource Analytics following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Determination of Home Team in Pac-12 Championship

The home team in the Pac-12 Championship Game will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the home team.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
3. Record in common conference games.
4. Highest ranking by SportSource Analytics following the last weekend of regular-season games.
5. Coin toss.
