PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSE

Davis Webb, Sr., QB, CAL

Completed 22-of-35 passes for 306 yards and 4 TDs in 28-23 win over No. 18 Utah. Each of his 4 TD passes were for at least 24 yards, including 56-yarder to Demetris Robertson in the fourth quarter that proved to be the winning margin. He leads the nation in TD passes (22) and passing yards (2,143).

DEFENSE

Psalm Wooching, Sr., LB, WASH

Had three of Washington's eight sacks and led a Husky defense that limited Stanford to 29 rushing yards and 184 passing yards in the 44-6 win. He finished with six total tackles and forced one fumble.

SPECIAL TEAMS

Davis Price, Fr., PK, COLO

Had his first career placekicks in 47-6 win over Oregon State, and set a CU record for longest field goal made by a freshman (54 yards). Finished with 11 points (5-5 PAT, 2-2 FG), and had four of his eight kickoffs go for touchbacks. He joined the team as a walk-on in June.

QUICK HITS

- COLORADO leads the Pac-12 South Division—the last time the Buffs led a division by themselves was after the games of Oct. 6, 2007, when they were 2-0 in the Big 12 North.
- WASHINGTON looks to move to 6-0 to start the season for the first time since 1992 when it started the season 8-0.
- ARIZONA STATE PK **Zane Gonzalez** is two field goals shy of matching the FBS career record of 88 set by Florida State's Dustin Hopkins (2009-12).
- The home team is 27-5 this season, and 9-3 in league play.

The Pac-12 posted has posted a winning record outside league for 31 consecutive seasons . . . The Pac-12 recorded a 35-12 record in non-conference action last season, and is 72-21 in non-conference play the last two seasons.

AROUND THE PAC-12

FWAA HONORS WASHINGTON: The Football Writers Association of America has selected the Washington Huskies as their National Team of the Week for their 44-6 victory over No. 7 Stanford.

SEPTEMBER PLAYMAKERS: The first month of the season has delivered some spectacular performances. WASHINGTON sophomore QB **Jake Browning** is second in the FBS in passing efficiency (196.3) and third in the TD passes (17) as the Huskies have averaged a Pac-12-leading 45.4 points per game, while the UW defense has been holding the opposition to a league-best 12.8 points per game. The Huskies are one of four teams that is among the FBS Top 10 in scoring offense (7th) and scoring defense (8th) (also Ohio State, Miami (FL), Michigan) ... CALIFORNIA senior QB **Davis Webb** has an FBS-best 22 TD passes and is averaging a league-leading 428.6 passing yards per game. His primary target has been junior WR **Chad Hansen**, who has pulled in 11.0 receptions per game, for 150.8 yards per game and 8 TDs ... COLORADO has vaulted into the Top 25 behind quarterbacks **Sefo Liufau** and **Steven Montez**. Liufau completed 54-of-76 for 768 yards and 6 TDs with no interceptions before getting injured at Michigan, then Montez stepped in and is 42-of-60 for 626 yards and 6 TDs with a pair of interceptions over the last two games. The CU secondary has led a resurgent Buff defense as it is responsible for a league-best 88.78 passing efficiency defense (3rd in FBS) as it allows just 150.4 passing yards per game ... UTAH sophomore P **Mitch Wishnowsky** has been above and beyond impersonating two-time Ray Guy Award winner Tom Hackett. Wishnowsky is leading the FBS with a 50.6 avg and eight of his 20 points downed inside the 20-yard line ... ARIZONA STATE senior PK **Zane Gonzalez** set the Pac-12 career scoring record earlier this season (447 points and counting) and is on the verge of establishing an FBS record for career field goals. He's at 86 and needs three to pass Florida State's Dustin Hopkins (88, 2009-12). Gonzalez is currently average 2.6 FG per game (2nd in FBS).

POLL NOTES: Four Pac-12 teams appear in this week's AP poll. It's the first time that four or more teams have been ranked in the AP poll since the preseason poll ... At No. 21, COLORADO makes its first appearance in the AP poll since 2005 when it was No. 22 during the week of Nov. 6. It's the highest ranking for the Buffs since they were No. 17 the week of Sept. 7, 2003 ... WASHINGTON is the eighth different Pac-12 team to appear in the AP Top 10 over the last three seasons. Washington has been in the AP Top 10 for five consecutive weeks, the longest stretch since it appeared in the last nine ranking periods during the 2000 season.

IN-ZANE: ARIZONA STATE senior PK **Zane Gonzalez** is quickly approaching the FBS record for career field goals. His 86 career field goals are a school and Pac-12 record and are third on the FBS all-time list led by Florida State's Dustin Hopkins (88). He moved ahead of UCLA's Kai Forbath's Pac-12 record of 85 set in 2007-10. He also moved past former Bruin Ka'imi Fairbairn (413 points, 2012-15) as the Pac-12's career scoring leader earlier this season. Gonzalez entered the season with 386 points and now has a Pac-12 career record of 447 points.

MAKING A POINT: Nineteen FBS teams are averaging 42.0 or more points per game through the first five weeks of the season, five hail from the Pac-12 - No. 7 WASHINGTON (45.4 ppg), No. 11 WASHINGTON STATE (44.3 ppg), No. 16 COLORADO (43.2 ppg), No. 17 ARIZONA STATE (43.0 ppg) and No. 19 CALIFORNIA (42.0).

THE SCHEDULE: The non-conference schedules include 18 opponents that participated in a bowl game last season. In all, 11 Pac-12 teams will face a team that appeared in a bowl game last season with USC facing three such opponents ... The Pac-12 posted a 35-12 record in non-conference play in 2015 and is 72-21 in non-league action over the previous two seasons ... Each Conference team will play a nine-game league schedule that includes five games within its own division and four games in the other division. Teams with the best record in their respective divisions will meet in the Pac-12 title game on Friday, Dec. 2 (FOX) at Levi's Stadium in Santa Clara, Calif.

PAC-12 SUCCESS IN RIO... OREGON WR/KR **Devon Allen** represented Team USA at the Rio Olympics in the 110m hurdles where he finished fifth ... USC CB/WR/KR **Adoree' Jackson** (long jump) and ARIZONA STATE WR/KR **Tim White** (triple jump) attempted to make the USA squad, but came up short ... Former Cal running back Jahvid Best (100m) represented St. Lucia ... If the Pac-12 was considered a country, it's student-athletes, both current and former, would have placed fifth in the medal count at the Rio Olympics:

THIS WEEK'S GAMES

COLORADO at USC

Sat., Oct. 8 • 1 p.m. PT • PAC12/PACMT/PACLA

COLORADO: Is 4-1 for the first time since the 2005 season, and 2-0 in league play for the first time since 2007. CU has won back-to-back Pac-12 games for the first time ... In the 47-6 win over Oregon State, the Buffs posted its largest margin of victory (41 points) since Oct. 24, 1992 (54-7 over Kansas State), and the six points allowed are the fewest in 47 Pac-12 games ... Freshman PK **Davis Price** set a record for longest FG by a CU freshman when he connected from 54 yards against OSU.

USC: The Trojans are facing No. 21 Colorado, their fourth ranked opponent in six games this season. All three of Troy's losses in 2016 have been to AP Top 25 teams ... USC's defense delivered in its win over Arizona State as it limited the Sun Devils to 75 yards rushing and 20 points. Arizona State entered the game averaging 236.5 yards rushing and 48.8 points per game ... Freshman QB **Sam Darnold** is 41-of-59 (.695) with no interceptions and 3 TDs (all to **JuJu Smith-Schuster** vs. Arizona State) in the starting role the last two games. Darnold has rushed for 61 yards in 2016, the most by a USC quarterback since Reggie Perry's 254 yards in 1991.

LAST MEETING (Nov. 13, 2015): USC overcame a 14-point deficit, using a trio of second half TD passes by QB Cody Kessler to hold on for a 27-24 win at Colorado. Trailing 17-6 entering the second half, USC scored 21 consecutive points on three drives, all on Kessler TD passes. Kessler finished 17-of-27 for 204 yards/3 TDs. Colorado QB Sefo Liufau suffered a season-ending foot injury in the first quarter, but backup QB Cade Aspay kept CU in reach as he was 18-of-23 for 128 yards/2 TDs.

WASHINGTON at OREGON

Sat., Oct. 8 • 4:30 p.m. PT • FOX

WASHINGTON: The 44-6 win over No. 7 Stanford was UW's largest margin of victory ever over AP Top 10 team ... The Huskies' defense recorded eight sacks, equaling the fourth most in UW single-game history. It was the most since they recorded 8 vs. Wyoming in 2002 ... The Huskies went over 200 yards rushing for the third straight game behind sophomore RB **Myles Gaskin** who turned in a 100-yard effort ... Over the last eight games, sophomore QB **Jake Browning** is 137-for-180 (.761) for 1,812 yards, 21 TDs and 3 INTs ... Outsourcing opponents 120-3 in the first half at home in four games this year. That's 58-0 in the first quarter and 62-3 in the second quarter.

OREGON: The Ducks are 2-3 for the first time since 2004 and look to avoid losing four straight for the first time since dropping the last four games of the 2006 season ... Junior RB **Royce Freeman** rushed for 138 yards (7.3 avg) and 3 TDs in the 51-33 loss at WSU. He now has 3,664 career rushing yards, moving him past Kenjon Barner on UO's career list and trails only LaMichael James. He now has 4,204 career all-purpose yards (ninth most in UO history) ... Junior WR **Charles Nelson** posted the second kickoff return for a TD in his career with a 100-yard return at WSU. He now has 1,877 kick return yards for his career, which is second all-time at Oregon.

LAST MEETING (Oct. 17, 2015): Vernon Adams went 14-of-25 for 272 yards, including five passes to Darren Carrington for 125 yards and 2 TDs as the Ducks defeated the Huskies, 26-20. Adams extended drives with third down completions of 48, 36, 24, 29, 44 and 27 yards on the night. Royce Freeman added 138 rushing yards on 27 carries. Washington's Jake Browning completed 19-of-30 for 199 yards/1 TD, while Myles Gaskin had 18 carries for 155 yards/1 TD.

CALIFORNIA at OREGON STATE

Sat., Oct. 8 • 6:30 p.m. PT • PAC12/PACBA/PACOR

CALIFORNIA: With the 28-23 win over No. 18 Utah, the Golden Bears have defeated multiple ranked teams for the first time since 2009 (No. 18 Arizona and No. 14 Stanford) ... Through five games, senior QB **Davis Webb** has thrown for 2,143 yards and 22 TDs ... Junior WR **Chad Hansen** (5 catches/98 yards/2 TDs vs. Utah), posted his third multi-receiving touchdown performance of the season ... Cal's 14 rushing attempts vs. Utah were the fewest ever in a game by the Bears in school history. The previous record was 18 against Washington State in 2014. The four first downs gained by a rush are also the fewest in a game by Cal in school history.

OREGON STATE: Look to snap a 12-game Conference skid and is searching for its first win over a North Division foe since a 49-17 win at California on Oct. 19, 2013 ... Beaver special teams have excelled behind junior PK **Garrett Owens** who has two or more field goals in two of OSU's four games. He is 6-of-8 (.750) this season and 28-for-36 (.778) all-time. Junior P **Nick Porebski** averaged 44.6 yards on eight punts at Colorado, with a long of 66 yards. He had four punts downed inside the 20-yard line.

LAST MEETING (Nov. 14, 2015): Jared Goff completed 26-of-37 for 453 yards and 6 TDs as the Bears pulled away in the second half to defeat the Beavers, 54-24. Cal's Tre Watson rushed 10 times for 110 yards. Oregon State QB Nick Mitchell, who completed 14-of-28 for 161 yards/2 TDs, connected on a 27-yard scoring strike at the end of the first half to keep the Beavers close at 24-10.

ARIZONA at UTAH

Sat., Oct. 30 • 8:00 p.m. MT • FS1

ARIZONA: True freshman **Khalil Tate** made his debut at quarterback at UCLA, finishing 5-for-9/72 yards/2 TDs and rushed for 79 yards on 15 carries. Tate is the first true freshman to see time at quarterback for Arizona since Matt Scott in 2008 and the first true freshman to throw multiple TD passes in his debut since Willie Tuitama in 2005 ... With a pair of receptions at UCLA, senior WR **Nate Phillips** extended his consecutive games with a reception streak to 38 games. He is tied with Virginia's Taquan Mizzell for the longest active of any Power 5 Conference players.

UTAH: Utah head coach Kyle Whittingham needs one more victory to reach career win No. 100. Whittingham is 99-47 in his 12th season ... With 442 yards of total offense in the 28-23 loss at Cal, Utah posted 400 or more yards of total offense for the fourth time this year ... The Utes held California to its lowest offensive output of the year with 362 yards ... First-year Sophomore P **Mitch Wishnowsky** saw his FBS best average drop from 52.1 to 50.6 after the Cal game, but it wasn't due to lack of effort. He punted three times and had two downed inside the 20-yard line (10, 5).

LAST MEETING (Nov. 14, 2015): Arizona QB Anu Solomon passed for 277 yards and two TDs and ran for a season-high 86 yards, but it was backup QB Jerrard Randall who delivered the game-winner in knocking off No. 10 Utah 37-30 in double overtime. Solomon was knocked out of the game with 9:25 left in regulation. Randall stepped in and completed one pass - a 25-yard TD pass to Nate Phillips on the first play of the second overtime. Utah's Devontae Booker rushed 24 times for 145 yards.

WASHINGTON STATE at STANFORD

Sat., Oct. 8 • 7:30 p.m. PT • ESPN

WASHINGTON STATE: With the 51-33 win over Oregon, the Cougars have posted back-to-back wins over the Ducks for the first time since 2002-2003 ... WSU's six rushing TDs are the most since rushing for six against Southwest Louisiana in 1997, and most against conference opponent since 1984 (six at Oregon) ... WSU's 280 rushing yards are the most since 2006 (344 against Idaho), and the most against a conference opponent since 2005 (330 against UCLA) ... Junior QB **Luke Falk** has thrown for 7,920 yards, fourth-most in WSU history ... Senior WR **Gabe Marks** has 256 career receptions (4th all-time in Pac-12). He needs four to move past Arizona State's Derek Hagan (258, 2002-05) and Arizona's Mike Thomas (259, 2005-08).

STANFORD: Since 2010, Stanford lost consecutive games only once. That occurred in 2014, when the Cardinal fell to Oregon and Utah, the latter in double-overtime ... In 71 games played under Shaw, Stanford has given up 20 or fewer points in 48 games ... Junior RB **Christian McCaffrey** had 233 all-purpose yards in the loss at Washington, with most of those coming on kick returns (144 yards). He was held to 49 yards on 12 carries and caught five passes for 30 yards.

LAST MEETING (Oct. 30, 2015): WSU kicker Erik Powell missed wide right on a 43-yard field goal as time expired, allowing Stanford to escape with a 30-28 win. Stanford's Conrad Ukropina kicked a 19-yard field goal with 1:54 left to put the Cardinal ahead. WSU outgained Stanford, 442 yards to 312 yards, behind Luke Falk's 354 yards passing. However it was the legs of Stanford QB Kevin Hogan who powered the Stanford ground game with 112 yards, including a 59-yard TD run, while Christian McCaffrey added 107 rushing yards.

UCLA at ARIZONA STATE

Sat., Oct. 8 • 7:30 p.m. PT • ESPN2

UCLA: The Bruins are 35-2 under head coach Jim Mora when leading at the half ... With a season-high 350 passing yards in the 45-24 win over Arizona, Sophomore QB **Josh Rosen** posted the ninth 300-yard passing game of his career, one behind Brett Hundley for second in UCLA history. He only needs 115 more yards to pass Troy Aikman (1987-1988) for seventh ... The Bruins have given up 10 first half points over the last three games ... Senior LB **Jayon Brown** is averaging 8.8 tackles per game and leading the Pac-12 with 30 solo tackles.

ARIZONA STATE: Senior PK **Zane Gonzalez** broke the Pac-12 career field goal records with his second field goal in the first quarter in the 41-20 loss at USC, bringing his career total to 86. He has now scored in each of the 44 games he has played and is just one behind Luis Zendejas for the ASU school record of 45 straight games. His 447 career points are just 19 behind Florida State's Dustin Hopkin's FBS record of 466 ... RS Freshman QB **Brady White** made his third appearance of the season after starter Manny Wilkins was injured in the second quarter. He completed his first career score with a 13-yard strike to Raymond Epps.

LAST MEETING (Oct. 3, 2015): Mike Bercovici passed for 273 yards and two TDs and ran for another, and Arizona State came away with a 38-23 victory. The Sun Devil defense held the UCLA rushing game to just 62 yards. UCLA's Josh Rosen completed 22-of-40 for 280 yards/2 TDs.
