Quick Hits

- Northern Colorado is coming off of an unexpected bye week, thanks to Mother Nature. The teams game at Florida was cancelled due to Hurricane Irma making its way through the state of Florida. The match-up between UNC and UF will not be made up due to no common open date for the two teams.

- It has been awhile since Northern Colorado and Colorado last met, 83 years to be exact. A few things have changed since then for both programs, including UNC winning a pair of DII National Championships (1996 & '97), while CU earned a national title in 1990.

- Northern Colorado started the season with a 41-14 win at home over College of Idaho. The team scored a touchdown on its first four possessions to lead 28-0 midway through the first quarter and never looked back.

- Kicker Collin Root, broke the school record on Saturday for longest field goal in program history. His 56-yard kick in the fourth quarter was the longest ever by a UNC player, breaking Ryan Anderson's record of 54 yards in 1993. That kick helped earn him the Root Sports Big Sky Special Teams Player of the Week honors.

- All five of UNC's touchdowns came on the ground against College of Idaho. Starting RB Trae Reik tallied three of those touchdowns, all coming in the first quarter. Jacob Knipp and Anthony Davis were the other two Bears who scored a rushing touchdown.

SCOUTING COLORADO

Colorado enters Saturday's game with a 2-0 record. The Buffs defeated Texas State, at home last weekend 37-3. Offensively CU is led by its running back Phillip Lindsay, who has ran for 227 yards on 45 carries this season for a pair of touchdowns. While the offense has been paced by Lindsay, as expected this year, Colorado's defense has been a bit of a surprise after losing over half its starters from last year. Over the first two games they have just allowed a field goal to each of its opponents, and forced five turnovers in two games.

ON THIS DATE

It has been 11 years since Northern Colorado has played on Sept. 16. The last time came in 2006 at Texas State where the Bears squeaked out a 14-13 win. Overall, on the date UNC is 5-3, going 1-3 away from Greeley.

BALL HAWKS?

A year ago Northern Colorado's young secondary intercepted just two passes for the season. The team already equaled that total through just one game, picking off College of Idaho twice. Linebacker Luke Nelson recorded the first pick of the season, and was soon followed up by cornerback Isaiah Swopes.

WELCOME BACK

Redshirt-junior quarterback Jacob Knipp returned to the field for the first time since breaking his clavicle last September against Abilene Christian. In his return, Knipp was 17-27 for 238 yards. He also showed off his legs with a nice 14-yard run during a drive and scored a touchdown on a 1-yard run.

SPECIAL TEAMS U

Teams around the nation already knew about the Northern Colorado return game thanks to the nightmares Hakeem Deggs and Ellis Onic II have been giving coaches over the past few years, but now they have to worry about the weapons the team possesses in the kicking game. Redshirt-sophomore Collin Root set a program record for longest field goal at 56 yards against College of Idaho and was 2-for-2 on his field goals. Meanwhile, Marques Combs continued to kick off well for the team with a touchback and averaging 57.6 yards per kickoff. Punter/safety Kiefer Glau punted three times last week with an average of 42.3 yards per boot. He pinned the Yotes inside the 20 once.

HEADING EAST

It is not often that Northern Colorado football has played in the Eastern Time Zone. The trip to Gainesville this weekend is only the second time in program history the Bears have played in the state of Florida. The other came in 2003 at Florida Atlantic. The Bears dropped that game 21-19 to the Owls.

BEAR IN THE NFL

Former UNC Bear Kyle Slotter made the most of his opportunity in training camp with the Denver Broncos this August, earning him a spot on the Minnesota Vikings practice squad. In his four preseason games with the Broncos, Slotter had a 72.1-percent completion percentage leading to 413 yards and three touchdowns, throwing no interceptions.

WHAT'S NEXT?

UNC returns home next week to open up Big Sky Conference play. The Bears hosts the Idaho State Bengals at 1 pm inside Nottingham Field. It's also the conference opener for ISU, who takes on Nevada this weekend in Reno.

Head Coach Earnest Collins Jr. continued the winning brand of football at the University of Northern Colorado in 2016.

For the second straight season Northern Colorado finished with a winning record, going 6-5. The team's offense was the best in its FCS history, producing FCS season-highs in nearly every offensive category. The Bears also accumulated the second-most wins in conference play since joining the Big Sky in 2006.

In his first year at the helm of the Bears, 2011, the team struggled through a winless season, but turned the tide and finished 2012 with a 5-6 record -- including a 4-4 mark in Big Sky Conference play. The Bears took a step backward in 2013, finishing with a 1-11 record and an 0-8 record in the conference.

But in 2015, for the first time in 12 years, the Bears finished with a winning record, going 6-5 after defeating Abilene Christian. It was the first-ever winning season in the team's FCS history and the first under Collins.

Collins, the Northern Colorado single-season school record holder in punt-return yards, and a former assistant coach for the Bears, was named head football coach on Dec. 28, 2010.

He is the 16th football coach in school history and the first to return to his alma mater to serve as head coach.

In 1996, Collins received his bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Northern Colorado after playing for the Bears from 1991-94, when he amassed 978 career punt-return yards, then the school record and still second all-time. His 497 punt-return yards during his 1994 senior season are still atop the school's leader board.

After a stellar career at Northern Colorado, where he lettered every season from 1991 through 1994 and earned all-conference honors in 1994, Collins spent 1996-99 at Northwest Missouri State as the secondary and assistant special teams coach, helping the Bearcats to the 1998 and 1999 NCAA Division II National Championships. In both seasons, Collins and the Bearcats got the best of the UNC Bears in the playoffs, winning the quarterfinals in 1998 in Maryville (42-17) and then winning the 1999 semifinals at Nottingham Field (41-35).

From 2000-03, Collins returned to Greeley, where he served as the secondary and special teams coach. In 2002, the Bears reached the NCAA Division II semifinals and had the top-ranked defense in the North Central Conference (NCC) and No. 8 defense among Division II teams (249.8 yards per game).

After his second coaching stint with UNC, Collins became the special teams and cornerbacks coach at Kansas from 2003-06. The Jayhawks advanced to two bowl games and he coached a pair of All-Americans in the defensive backfield.

He spent 2007 at Central Florida before heading to Alcorn State in 2008 as the associate head coach. In 2009, he was promoted to head coach at Alcorn State.

In two years at the helm of Alcorn State, the Braves went 8-12 with significant signs of improvement. Alcorn State ranked 30th in FCS in scoring offense in 2010, averaging 29.64 points per game.

Collins and his wife, Tabatha, have two daughters, Tayler and Marci, and a son, DeShawn.

In January 2011, Jon Boyer returned to his alma mater to coach quarterbacks for the second time in his career, and in 2012 he became the offensive coordinator. He has continued to coach the quarterbacks in addition to his increased role.

One of the most prolific quarterbacks in school history, Boyer had the opportunity to work with another name scattered throughout the record books in Seth Lobato. Lobato went on to break nearly every passing record in the Division I era at UNC and continued his career at the professional level.

In one of his finest coaching performances, Boyer in 2016 recovered from the season-ending injury to starter Jacob Knipp in Game 2, by guiding his replacement, Kyle Slotter, to the NFL as an undrafted free agent.

In his first season as the offensive coordinator, 2012, the Bears increased their offensive production by almost 70 yards per game, from 293.7 in 2011 to 361 yards in 2012. The biggest gain was in the rushing game as the team went from just 56.1 yards to 101.9.

Boyer graduated from the University of Northern Colorado in May 2002 after serving as the starting quarterback for the 2000 and 2001 teams. While with the Bears, Boyer threw for 4,529 yards and 32 touchdowns over 22 games. His passing yards still rank eighth on the school's career charts.

Upon his graduation, Boyer was a strength and conditioning coach in Greeley before his first stint with the Bears coaching staff in 2004 and 2005. During those two years, Boyer served as the quarterbacks coach and received his master's degree in sport and exercise science sport pedagogy.

In 2007, Boyer joined the Colorado Mesa coaching staff, serving as the offensive coordinator as well as overseeing the coaching duties for the quarterbacks, running backs and wide receivers.

Boyer is married to the former Vanessa Gates, who also received her master's degree in education from Northern Colorado. The pair have two children, a daughter, Ava, and a boy, Beau.

O. Kay Dalton returned to Northern Colorado Football in spring 2011 as an offensive consultant. He's considered one of the brightest and most-respected minds in all of football, at any level, and his presence back with the Bears is, indeed, a welcome sight.

Dalton has served as an assistant or head football coach nearly all of the past 50 years, and he was the Bears' head coach from 2000-05, compiling a 38-31 record. He was also head coach for the CFL's Montreal Alouettes, as well as Western State and Trinidad State.

His assistant-coaching stops included four NFL teams, two CFL teams and two NCAA Division I programs, before arriving at UNC in 1989.

From 1974-77, Dalton was the Denver Broncos' receivers coach, developing Floyd Little and Riley Odoms into Pro Bowlers. For the next eight years, Dalton served as an assistant with the Buffalo Bills, Kansas City Chiefs and Houston Oilers, coaching such stars as Earl Campbell, Warren Moon and O.J. Simpson. While at Kansas City, Dalton coached former UNC quarterback Bill Kenney.

Dalton returned to the Broncos and spent two more years as their receivers coach, when he coached the famed Three Amigos (Mark Jackson, Vance Johnson and Ricky Nattiel), John Elway's favorite targets in the mid-1980s. He then returned to his alma mater, Colorado State, where he served as offensive coordinator from 1987-88, before arriving at UNC in 1989.

Dalton earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from CSU in 1954 and his master's degree in psychology and counseling from CSU in 1958. A three-year starter at tight end for CSU, Dalton was a teammate of former UNC coaches Bob Blasi and Buck Rollins. He earned All-America honors in 1953.

He was inducted into the CSU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2000 and the Northern Colorado Athletic Hall of Fame in 2013. Dalton and his wife, June, reside in Greeley.

In 2011, Keith Grable moved back to coaching the position he played on the field for the Bears, wide receiver. He continues his duties as recruiting coordinator as he starts his 17th year on the coaching staff in 2017.

Grable, however, has been a member of the Bears family for much longer than that. He was a wide receiver for each of the Bears' national championship teams, in 1996 and 1997, and earned all-academic honors in both 1998 and 1999.

Grable and his twin brother, Dean, both played basketball and football at Northern Colorado.

Most recently, Grable has coached wideout Dimitri Stimpfil (2011-14) who broke the program's Division I career record in receiving yards and consecutive receptions. He was also the Bears' last 1,000-yard season receiver.

In his first year with the wide receivers, Grable coached Patrick Walker, who capped a stellar senior season with six straight 100-yard receiving games and a school- and conference-record 315 yards against North Dakota.

Grable also coached Andre Wilson to the career rushing record at Northern Colorado, as he amassed 3,561 yards in his four seasons. Wilson was a two-time first-team all-conference selection in the Great West, as well as a second-team All-Big Sky selection in 2006.

In 2003, Grable helped running back Adam Matthews set the Bears' single-season rushing record at 1,653 yards.

As a volunteer coach for the Bears, Grable assisted in the development of Brad Pyatt, who played for the Indianapolis Colts for several years, and helped George Carroll and Eric Nelson become two of the Bears' top-10 receivers all-time.

A four-year letterwinner for the Bears from 1996-99, Grable is remembered for his clutch third-down receptions during the national championship runs. He still ranks among the best at Northern Colorado, ranking seventh with 1,965 receiving yards. He was named to the All-NCC first team as a senior in 1999.

Grable earned his bachelor's degree in 2000 and completed his master's degree in 2002 in physical education/pedagogy, both from the University of Northern Colorado. He is a native of Thornton, Colo., and prepped at Horizon High School.

Grable and his wife Susan have three sons, Jaxon, Ryan and Austin.

Trevor Wikre was named the Bears offensive line coach in March 2014 and enters his fourth year at UNC.

Prior to the Bears, he spent two years at Adams State in a similar role. While there, the Grizzlies posted back-to-back school records in single-season rushing yards, and Wikre had two players named to the RMAC all-conference team. In 2012, Adams State went 9-2, the best record since the school joined the Division II ranks. In 2013, the Grizzlies ranked third in the RMAC in rushing – in one of the toughest conferences in Division II.

Originally from Longmont, Colo., Wikre was an all-state lineman at Berthoud (Colo.) High School, where he was an all-state and all-conference selection. A state qualifier in wrestling, he also lettered in baseball.

After Berthoud, Wikre attended Colorado Mesa, where he played defensive tackle his first two years and moved to offensive guard his final two seasons. He was an all-conference selection as a junior and senior, adding All-America honors in his final year. He graduated in 2009 with a bachelor's degree in both physical education and adaptive physical education.

Wikre moved to the coaching ranks in 2009, spending three seasons at Colorado State, the first as a quality control defensive assistant and the other two as a defensive graduate assistant. During that time, he completed his master's degree in education.

His name is well known around the collegiate ranks. Midway through his senior season he suffered a compound dislocation of his finger that caused ligament damage. Doctors told him the damage would prevent his return to the gridiron, but in order to preserve his career, Wikre chose to have his finger amputated. He missed just one game for the Mavericks, returning for the final five games of the year. His story was told around the country, including articles in Sports Illustrated, People, New York Times, USA Today, Sunday NFL Countdown and ESPN Magazine. He also had a guest appearance on ESPN's First Take, and with Mike and Mike In The Morning.

Wikre and his wife, the former Traci Young, have a newborn son, Jack.

Named for Northern Colorado Hall of Famer Vic Nottingham, who played tennis for the Bears from 1948-52 and has been an invaluable contributor to the program, Nottingham Field opened its doors on Sept. 9, 1995.

The stadium's first game pitted Northern Colorado against Colorado Mesa and the Bears were most ungracious hosts, handing the Mavericks a 58-7 defeat.

The Bears went on to win their first 13 games at Nottingham and entered 2017 with a 73-48 record at home since moving over from Jackson Field.

In the last several years Northern Colorado has made several renovations to the stadium.

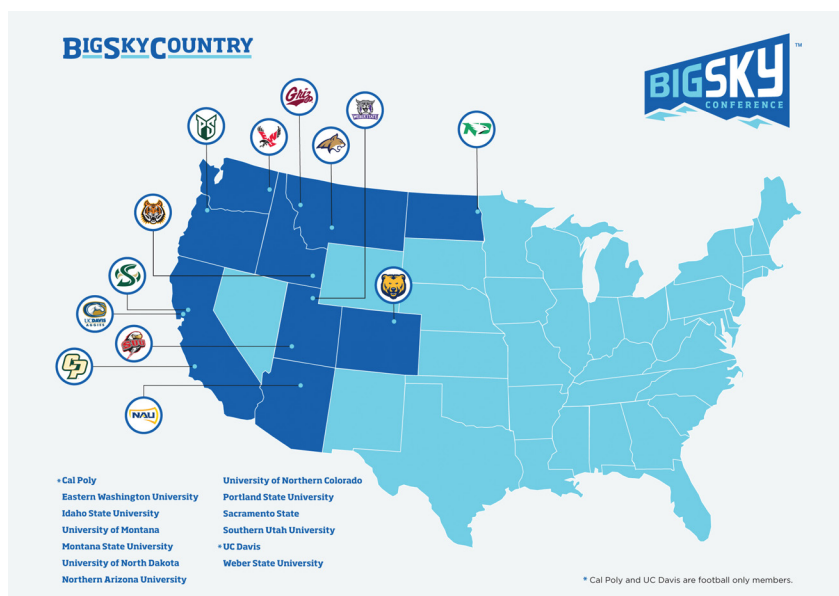
The facility saw an across-the-board facelift in spring 2007 that included upgraded concessions, new restrooms and ticket booths. The East Plaza Concourse is now the hub of activity on game day.

Then, in summer 2011, the High Plains Club on the west side of the stadium saw an upgrade. A VIP donor lounge was created, complete with a built-in bar, ample seating, new carpet and a pair of high-definition flat-screen TVs.

The 2012 season brought a new sound system to Nottingham Field, resulting in crisper gameday music and public-address system. Over the 2013 summer, the track surrounding the field was resurfaced and several amenities were added to the terraces.

The summer of 2014 brought in a brand-new Daktronics video board to enhance the game-day experience, and 2015 brought in a video replay room and wind screens.

Last season saw the interior of Nottingham get a facelift with new graphics in the High Plains Room and the second level terrace lobby. The graphics were put in place to instill the rich history and tradition of success of the football program.
