

Over the last year, CU has lost four Hall of Famers and a “Hall of Fame” Super Fan. Three players, receiver Cliff Branch, defensive end Herb Orvis, and running back Carroll Hardy all are members of CU’s Athletic Hall of Fame (Orvis was also inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame; Hardy lettered 10 times in three different sports; Branch also was a world class sprinter). Mike Moran was CU’s sports information director (1968-79) and was inducted into the CoSIDA Hall of Fame; and Betty Hoover along with her twin sister (Peggy Coppom) held season tickets since 1958 and were CU fans beginning in the 1940’s.






Carroll Hardy
