Postgame Quotes

Arizona head coach Kevin Sumlin

On challenges coming into this week...

"It is the execution for four quarters in all three phases and we were not perfect and that is what we have been talking about for the last two weeks. If we played for four quarters and execute, then we will check the score board. "

On the team the last couple weeks...

"Obviously we moved people around. We have lost a couple of guys in the back end and at linebacker, and I think [Anthony] Pandy has really given us a chance to get Tony [Fields] and Colin [Schooler] off the field and rotate them, so those guys are not playing 75 plays. The move of PJ [Johnson] to end has really helped to get our best players on the field and we have had some guys come on and make some plays. I think there is a growing confidence in those guys around each other just because they have played a lot of football and been all over the place. We have had a rotating lineup really the first five, six weeks and with guys that were injured out. I think what you're seeing is about the same roughly, 14, 15 guys putting on defense right now, we communicate."

On how special it was for J.J. Taylor to look as good on his 40th carry as he did on his first...

"We know the plan is not to hand it to him 40 times. J.J. [Taylor], he is a machine. He wants to play and he plays hard. You look at some of those runs and his big games 200 or 300 yards. He has ripped off some explosive plays, 40, 50, 60 yard runs, tonight, his longest was 21. He worked for every yard he got and I think our offensive line did a nice job, and schematically our offensive staff did a nice job of attacking the edges. I think Khalil [Tate] carrying out his fakes and doing some other things really has helped because you could see when he took off and ran tonight, that's the first time anybody has seen him hit that."

Arizona junior quarterback Khalil Tate

On what's been clicking for the team in the last few weeks...

"We've really just been playing all four quarters. That's something Coach (Kevin) Sumlin has preached to us since the beginning of the season. We're finally starting to understand that and show it on the field."

On throwing the ball tonight...

"We were just efficient. We really took that into consideration on offense and we haven't been as good in the past few games. I was telling them we need to step up on our end. Defense does their job and offense needs to continue and keep improving."

Arizona RS junior defensive tackle PJ Johnson

On what this year has been like for him...

"It's been amazing. I've been through a lot in my life. I have a lot of great teammates here. No matter what happens, they keep my spirits up. Now I'm playing football and I'm healthy. I try to stay positive and I have some great teammates that keep me up all the time."

Arizona RS sophomore running back J.J. Taylor

On if it felt like he had 40 carries in the game...

"I was just doing what I was told and making the most out of the opportunities I was given."

On the third down play late in the game on their own goal line...

"The whole situation was to make sure you didn't stay in the end zone, but get the first down and seal the deal. That was just the mentality."

Arizona sophomore linebacker Colin Schooler

On how important it was to back up the win over Oregon with this win over Colorado...

"It's huge. We have a bye week coming up this week. So it's good to go into that with momentum and get healthy next week."

On Laviska Shenault Jr. not playing...

"Well we know he's a big target for them, so having him not in the game obviously changes what they do. We just had to stick to our game plan, and we if we execute it properly, then we're not going to give up as many yards."

Colorado head coach Mike McIntyre

Opening Statement...

"I thought our players battled and we had opportunities to win the football game. Arizona made some big plays. Khalil ran around and threw the ball up in the air and their guys came down with it on long-delayed plays. Those plays are tough to stop. We've got to get a better pass rush and we can't cover the gap for that long downfield that many times."

On how the team played this week...

"Our guys came and played really hard. I thought they came out of the chute and they played really, really hard. Arizona made a couple plays by Khalil running around and throwing it up and that's basically how they scored three of their touchdowns. I have to give credit to Arizona for doing that and for making those plays."

On the difficulty to gain consistency in their offense...

"I thought that we did some good things. We should have scored a couple more times down there. We overthrew one and that's three points that Steven Montez would like to have back. He played really well, but that was one you'd like to have back to Kabion Ento. And then I think Kabion should have caught one that Steven put it right on there. If you combine those two together, that would've been the difference in the football game."

Is this the toughest challenge of your head coaching career to this point and try to get this team?

"I think every year's a tough year and every game is a tough game. We've got a ton of people out and I thought the way the guys kept fighting and not hanging their head with all these players going down was impressive and I think they just have to keep battling. And the coaches and staff have to keep battling and fighting and keep finding a way."

Colorado junior quarterback Steven Montez

On the mood of the team....

"It sucks, that's the only way to describe it. It sucks not winning, especially how hard we work week in and week out. It's tough. But I mean these tough games, these tough losses, they're going to tell you a lot about the team that we've got. And I thought, for the game we had last week, we came out and fought. I thought our guys played really well, we just have to do a better job of when opportunities present themselves, we have to make the plays. I don't think it's a question of effort or going playing hard, guys giving it all they've got. I think what's holding us back is when we have those opportunities to make those plays, we have to capture them, we have to make them."

On missed opportunities...

"There are opportunities all over the place where we could've gotten. There was a fade at the beginning of the game that I missed wide and that's on me. It was there, the opportunity to score a touchdown was there. We just didn't execute. We have to start executing if we want to have a chance to win these close games."

On the offensive performance...

"We had some drives and put some plays together and we're starting to make positive plays. There was a little bit of consistency, but there was pressure all night. But the good ones find a way to get it done. We just have to come back and keep working and stay hungry. It's easy to slip into that mentality, since we've lost four in a row. That can't be how you look at the game that every week is a new opportunity. People can be beaten. I know Washington State is a good team, but they have to play us at Folsom, so we're going to give them our best shot."

On the team mentality...

"I think overall we've stayed positive. I think it's all about those opportunities to execute and we have to do a better job of executing when they show up."

Colorado senior wide receiver Juwann Winfree

On dealing with injuries...

"It's been super tough, we all have to deal with that, including myself, I've missed four games. Laviska (Shenault) is out. It's tough because you never know when it's going to happen. But our guys stepped up and made plays, not enough plays, but I feel like the people who came in for the injured players stepped up. You just have to deal with adversity, injury comes with football. That's expected but it's how you bounce from that."

On stepping up in the offense...

"We're hungry. We haven't gotten that many opportunities this season, so we were ready to make plays. We were preached to all week about how we were going to have to make plays and how the game was going to rely on offense. That's how we approach it, day in and day out. We're just trying to look the best, catch every day and work hard."

Colorado now leads the series by a 14-7 margin, as Arizona has won the last two in the series ... Colorado is now 4-6 in the modern era (post-World War II) with five days in-between games (1-2 with four days rest) ... Colorado did not commit a turnover last week against Oregon State, and went 83 plays on offense between turning it over when K.D. Nixon fumbled on fourth down on the first series ... There were 10 points scored in the first quarter, 7 in the fourth; 59 combined in the second and third; the winner of the game in all eight Pac-12 meetings between the two since CU joined the league in 2011 has scored at least 38 points in each ... The Buffs have outscored opponents 80-31 in the first quarter ...

Colorado has lost four games in a row by a combined 40 points (two one-score and two two-score games ... WR Laviska Shenault, the nation's leader in receptions per game (10.0) as well as yards per game (130.0) missed his third straight game with a toe injury; the Buffs lost two other receivers tonight when K.D. Nixon (lower body) and Jay MacIntyre (concussion) left the game in the first half.

And Then There Were Four. When PK Tyler Francis made CU's first PAT, he became the fourth player to attempt a placekick (FG and/or PAT) this season for CU – that tied for the most at Colorado since the end of the platoon era (1965-on). He joined James Stefanou (out with a hip strain) and the Price brothers (Davis and Evan, the latter whom did not make the trip due to illness). CU also had four players attempt kicks in 2016 (Diego Gonzalez, Chris Graham, Alex Kinney and Davis Price) and in 1976 (Pete Dadiotis, Tim Mangnall, Bobby Morris and Mark Zetterberg). Francis is a true freshman walk-on from Carlsbad, Calif., who joined the team for August camp (he didn't kick in high school until his senior year; he has a soccer background).

▶ Francis was perfect in his collegiate debut, scoring 10 points as he made was 4-of-4 on PAT kicks and 2-of-2 on field goals from 25 and 48 yards.

O-Line Hat Trick. Colorado started three freshmen on the offensive line for the second straight game; the first time in its history was last week. The same trio started: LT Will Sherman, C Colby Pursell, RT Frank Fillip; Fillip is a true frosh.

Busting Through. The 59-yard punt return in the first quarter by CB Ronnie Blackmon was the second-longest by a Buffalo in the last 13 seasons; Isaiah Oliver returned one 68 yards for a TD against UCLA in Boulder in 2016. It was the longest away from Boulder by a Buff since Jeremy Bloom returned one 80 yards for a TD against Oklahoma in the 2002 Big 12 Championship Game.

Postgame Notes

- Redshirt sophomore running back J.J. Taylor rushed for 192 yards on 40 carries in Friday night's win. It marked the third straight game Taylor has rushed for at least 150 yards. Taylor is the first Arizona running back to rush for at least 150 yards in three straight games since Ka'Deem Carey closed out the 2013 season with three-straight 150-yard games.
- Junior quarterback Khalil Tate passed for a career-high 350 yards in the win. He completed 17 of 22 passes and tied his career high with five touchdown passes. He had five completions of 30 or more yards to five different receivers. Tate now has thrown five touchdown passes in three games in his career, becoming the first Arizona quarterback ever to do that. Willie Tuitama and Anu Solomon each did it twice. Tate was one touchdown shy of tying Tom Tunnicliffe's school record of six, set in 1982 versus Pacific.
- Tate now has 19 touchdown passes on the season, which is tied with Nick Foles (2009), Jason Johnson (2001) and Ortege Jenkins (1997) for ninth all-time in single-season history at Arizona.
- Arizona scored 26 points in the second quarter Friday. That marked the highest single-quarter output in a conference game since the Wildcats scored 36 points in the fourth quarter against Cal in 2014 in a 49-45 victory.
- Senior receiver Shawn Poindexter caught two passes for 40 yards and two touchdowns. It's the third straight week Poindexter has had two touchdown catches in a game. Poindexter's last four catches -- spanning the past two games -- have all gone for touchdowns.
- Poindexter now has eight touchdown catches on the season, which is the most by an Arizona receiver since Cayleb Jones had nine in 2014. The senior has multiple touchdown catches in three straight games. He's the first Arizona receiver to do that since Austin Hill in 2012 versus Oregon State, Stanford and Washington.
- Senior receiver Shun Brown finished with five catches for 57 yards and a touchdown. Brown now has 127 catches for his career and is one away from tying Cayleb Jones and David Roberts for 12th all-time at Arizona. His touchdown catch was the 14th of his career, and he's now tied with Jones for 13th all-time. Brown now has 1,660 career yards, which moves him into 14th all-time at Arizona.
- Arizona finished with five sacks in the win Friday night, marking a new season high. It's the first time Arizona has had five sacks since last season's 47-30 win over UCLA.
- Senior safety Demetrius Flannigan-Fowles finished with a season-high nine tackles Friday night. He had two tackles-for-loss, which established a new career high. He also recorded his first career sack. He has five tackles-for-loss on the season, which is a new career high as well.
- Colin Schooler finished with nine tackles, including three for a loss. He topped the 100-tackle mark on the season and now has 101 tackles through 10 games. Schooler has 19 tackles-for-loss on the season, which is better than 21 of the past 22 end-of-season leaders for Arizona.
- Redshirt junior Cedric Peterson had two catches for 72 yards and a touchdown. The 72 yards established a new career high, besting his previous high of 63 set earlier this year at Utah.
- Redshirt sophomore receiver Devaughn Cooper finished with two catches for 63 yards. The 63 yards are a new career high. Cooper's previous high was 57 yards set earlier this season against Utah.
- Sophomore kicker Lucas Havrisik converted on field goals of 55 and 49 yards in the win Friday. The 55-yarder was two shy of his career high set last year. Arizona kickers have converted on their last 10 field goal attempts this season.
