QUICK HITS

- For the fifth time this season, a pair of ranked Pac-12 teams will face each other when No. 14 WASHINGTON STATE visits No. 24 STANFORD. Two of the Pac-12's top passing teams will look to air it out behind WSU's **Gardner Minshew II** (392.1 passing yards per game) and the Stanford's **K.J. Costello** (263.1 passing yards per game). It's no wonder that five of the league's top 12 receivers (in receptions per game) will be featured in the game: WSU's **Tay Martin** (6.6 rec/g), **James Williams** (5.6 rec/g) and **Easop Winston** (4.6 rec/g); Stanford's **JJ Arcega-Whiteside** (5.3 rec/g) and **Trent Irwin** (4.9 rec/g).

PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSE

Tyler Huntley, QB, UTAH

Completed 22 of 29 pass attempts (.759) for a career-high-tying 341 yards and four touchdowns in Utah's 41-28 win over USC. Also rushed for 33 rushing yards and a touchdown in amassing 374 yards of total offense. Huntley's 46-yard touchdown pass to Britain Covey on third down and five in the first quarter sparked a run of 34 unanswered points by Utah. Huntley's scoring drives averaged 82 yards per drive.

DEFENSE

Chase Hansen, LB, UTAH

Hansen led Utah with 11 tackles (3.0 TFL) and his second interception of the season in Utah's 41-28 win over USC. Hansen was integral in holding USC to just 3-of-14 on third down conversions, including 0-10 through the first three quarters. His interception came in the first quarter on the USC 20, eventually setting up the field goal that closed USC's lead to four (14-10). 10 of his 11 tackles stopped USC from a first down. With his 3.0 tackles for loss against USC, he has 14.0 on the season, ranking second in the Pac-12 and fourth in the nation.

SPECIAL TEAMS

Matt Gay, PK, UTAH

Gay was 2-for-2 on field goals and 5-for-5 on PATs against USC. He had seven kickoffs for 459 yards (65.6 average) with five touchbacks. His 33-yard field goal to open the second quarter cut USC's lead to 14-10, then added a 30-yard field goal as time expired in the second quarter, giving Utah a 20-14 lead. He leads the Pac-12 in scoring by a kicker per game (8.0) and field goals per game (1.43). He is a perfect 6-for-6 in the 30-39-yard range this season.

PAC-12 FOOTBALL NOTEBOOK

THE RANKINGS: For the second time this season, five Pac-12 teams are ranked in both the AP poll and the Coaches poll. WASHINGTON STATE (14/15) makes the biggest jump in the AP poll this week, moving up 11 places, followed by WASHINGTON (15/13), OREGON (19/21), UTAH (23/24), and STANFORD (24/23) ... Washington State has now appeared in the AP Top 25 for 41 consecutive ranking periods, and have been in the Top 10 in 29 of the last 40 ranking periods ... Utah makes its first appearance in the AP poll this season, becoming the ninth different Pac-12 team to grace the rankings this year.

THE ROAD MORE TRAVELED... Pac-12 teams are 18-3 (.857) at home in non-conference play, but just 15-11 (.576) on the home turf in league play ... Four of the five ranked Pac-12 teams are on the road this week.

LAST THREE... Both UTAH and WASHINGTON STATE are riding three-game winning streaks and have put up impressive numbers during that successful stretch of games ... Over the last three games for Utah: Ute rush defense has allowed 62.3 rushing yards per game ... Ute offense has averaged 41.0 ppg ... QB **Tyler Huntley** has completed 53-of-69 passes (.768) for 741 yards (247.0 avg) and 7 TDs and just one interception ... RB **Zack Moss** has rushed for 364 yards (121.3 avg) and 3 TDs ... Over the last three games for Washington State: Cougar pass defense is allowing just 203 passing yards per game on 55-of-91 passes (.604) and just one receiving TD, while collecting nine sacks and 21 tackles for loss ... QB **Gardner Minshew II** is 100-for-147 (.680) for 1,198 yards (399.3 ypg) and 12 TDs.

TAKING A STAND: Washington LB **Ben Burr-Kirven** leads all Pac-12 players with 10 or more tackles in a game six times this season. He has compiled a league-best 108 tackles to date for a 13.5 tackles per game (2nd in the FBS). Here's list of those defensive stalwarts with the most games having double-digit tackles:

THORPE AWARD SEMIFINALISTS: The Paycom Jim Thorpe Award tabs a pair of Pac-12 safeties as semifinalist for the prestigious honor that recognizes the best defensive back in the nations - senior **Ugochukwu Amadi**, ORE and senior **Taylor Rapp**, WASH. Conference players who have earned the award include Mark Carrier, USC (1994); Darryl Lewis, ARIZ (1990); Antoine Cason, ARIZ (2007); Adoreé Jackson, USC (2016). Colorado's Deon Figures (1992) and Chris Hudson (1994) claimed the award, but that was prior to the Buffs joining the Pac-12.

BOW UP: Washington QB **Jake Browning** and RB **Myles Gaskin** are climbing the Pac-12 career charts and are among the all-time top ten in several categories.

PAC-12 HEADLINERS: Among 177 returning starters are a number of headliners, including a total of 10 first-team and 12 second-team All-Pac-12 performers. Nine of the 12 squads return at least six starters on offense, and seven squads return at least six starters on defense ... Returning are the reigning Offensive Player of the Year in Stanford senior running back **Bryce Love**, as well as the Freshman Co-Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year in Arizona running back **J.J. Taylor** and Stanford offensive lineman **Walker Little**, and Arizona linebacker **Colin Schooler**. Four teams have multiple returning First Team all-conference performers - USC linebacker **Cameron Smith**, defensive back **Marvell Tell** and all-purpose/special teams **Michael Pittman Jr.**; Stanford's Love and offensive lineman **Nate Herbig**; Washington offensive lineman **Kaleb McGary** and defensive back **Taylor Rapp**; Utah placekicker **Matt Gay** and punter **Mitch Wishnowsky**. Additional returning first team performers include Arizona State junior wide receiver **N'Keal Henry** and Oregon junior all-purpose/special teams **Brenden Schooler**.

AROUND THE PAC-12

UTAH (5-2) at UCLA (2-5)
Fri., Oct. 26 • 7:30 pm MT • ESPN • #UTAHvsUCLA

UTAH: In the 41-28 win over USC, Utah held the Trojans to 73 rushing yards, the fifth time this season the Utes have held their opponent under 100 yards rushing ... The Utes have given up a combined total of 187 rushing yards over the last four games (46.8 avg) ... Utah has scored 40 or more points in three straight games, last pulling off that feat in 2010 (vs. New Mexico, San Jose State and Iowa State) ... QB **Tyler Huntley** completed 22-of-29 for 341 yards and 4 TDs, plus 33 rushing yards and one rushing TD. It was his first 300-yard passing game of the season, fourth of his career ... RB **Zack Moss** led Utah in rushing with 136 yards on 25 carries, his fourth game this season he has rushed for over 100 yards (nine career) ... LB **Chase Hansen** led the Utes with 11 tackles, his third double-digit game this season. He has led, or tied for the team lead, in tackles in six of Utah's seven games this year.

UCLA: In its 31-30 win over Arizona, UCLA recorded a season-best 460 yards of total offense, including a season-best 307 passing yards ... Has forced nine turnovers in its last three games. UCLA forced 13 turnovers all of last year ... UCLA posted its first back-to-back, Pac-12 Conference wins since 2015 (Colorado/Oregon State) ... RB **Joshua Kelley** rushed for 136 yards on a career-high 31 carries to record his fourth, 100-yard rushing game in a row. It was the second-straight game with at least 30 carries for Kelley. Tyler Ebell, who was the last Bruin to notch back-to-back, 30-carry games, had six 100-yard rushing contests in a row in 2002. ... PK **JJ Molson** has now connected on 17 of his last 19 field goal attempts over the past two seasons.

OREGON STATE (1-6) at COLORADO (5-2)
Sat., Oct. 27 • 1:00 p.m. MT • P12N • #OSUvsCU

OREGON STATE: RB **Jemar Jefferson**, the Pac-12's leading rusher (128.4 avg), rushed for 34 yards in the loss to California that brought his season rushing total to 899 yards. He has 12 rushing TDs on the season. Only seven other Beavers all-time have scored more than 12 rushing TDs in a single season. The Pac-12 record for rushing TDs in a season by a freshman is 18 (Oregon's Royce Freeman in 2014). He needs 101 more yards to become the first Beaver to reach 1,000 yards in a season since Jacquizz Rodgers put up 1,440 yards in 2009 ... S **Jalen Moore** matched a season-high with 13 tackles, while LB **Shemar Smith** finished with a career-high 12 tackles ... The Beavers look to snap a 17-game skid in Pac-12 road games. Their last Conference road win came at Colorado (36-31 on Oct. 4, 2014).

COLORADO: CU started five freshmen at Washington: LE **Israel Antwine**, CB **Chris Miller**, C **Colby Pursell**, LT **William Sherman** and WR **Dimitri Stanley**. That's the most since Oct. 10, 2015, when six started at Arizona State (ILB Rick Gamboa, TE Dylan Keeney, RT John Lisella, WR Jay MacIntyre, CB Isaiah Oliver and WR Lee Wa ... WR **Daniel Arias** became the 16th known player in CU history to score a touchdown on his first career touch when he caught a 37-yard TD pass from **Steven Montez** to open the day's scoring. Four of those 16 are on this current CU team (all WRs: Jay MacIntyre, Kabion Ento and Laviska Shenault, though Shenault's came on a fumble return on a punt) ... **Brady Russell** caught four passes and **Chris Bounds** one at Washington, the first by CU's tight ends this season.

ARIZONA STATE (3-4) at USC (4-3)
Sat., Oct. 27 • 12:30 pm PT • ABC/ESPN2 mirror • #ASUvsUSC

ARIZONA STATE: After coming up short in a 20-13 setback to Stanford, each of ASU's four losses this season have been by one score ... The Sun Devils entered the game with Stanford having committed just two turnovers this season, but uncharacteristically turned it over three times to the Cardinal ... QB **Manny Wilkins** tossed a rare pick, ending a streak of 164 passes without an interception ... WR **N'Keal Harry** had eight receptions for 91 yards and has now collected a reception in each of the 32 games he's played. He moved to eighth in school history in career receiving yards with 2,220. (Ninth place is Jaelen Strong with 2,373) ... No ASU running back has lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 681 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season and reaching 25 consecutive games ... The Sun Devils have yet to allow more than 30+ points in a game this year, one of 12 teams in the nation to do so.

USC: **Clay Helton** is 19-0 in the Coliseum as USC's head coach. The Trojans are 15-2 against the Pac-12 South Division under Helton ... ILBs **John Houston Jr.** (15) and **Palaie Gaoteote IV** (11), a freshman who filled in for the injured Cameron Smith, had double digit tackles at Utah. S **Talanoa Hufanga** (12) and DL **Christian Rector** (10) chipped in with double-digit takedowns as well ... USC's 19-game home winning streak, its longest since a school-record 21 in a row from 2001 to 2004 (not including 6 wins later vacated due to NCAA penalty; original record: 35 in a row from 2001 to 2007) and currently the second longest regular season home winning streak in the nation (behind Alabama's 24) ... WR **Michael Pittman Jr.** is fourth nationally (second in the Pac-12) with 22.4 yards per reception. He's pulled in 21 receptions for 471 yards and 4 TDs.

WASHINGTON (6-2) at CALIFORNIA (4-3)
Sat., Oct. 27 • 3:30 pm PT • FS1 • #UWvsCAL

WASHINGTON: QB **Jake Browning's** record as a starter is 35-12 and he's one victory shy of matching the Pac-12 career record of 36 wins by a starting quarterback, which is shared by Oregon's Marcus Mariota (2012-14) and Stanford's Kevin Hogan (2012-15) ... He's now eighth in career passing yards (11,005) and ninth in career total offense (11,200) in the Pac-12 ... Browning is just the sixth player in Pac-12 history to account for 100 touchdowns (104 total: 89 pass, 15 rush) ... RB **Myles Gaskin** needs 337 rushing yards to reach 1,000 yards for the season. If accomplished, he'd be the first player in Pac-12 history and 10th ever in FBS history to rush for 1,000 or more yards in four seasons... LB **Ben Burr-Kirven** led the Huskies in tackles for the seventh time in eight games this season as he posted 15 tackles (8 solo, 7 assists) in the win over Colorado. He currently leads the Pac-12 with 108 tackles and is second in the nation with 13.5 tackles per game.

CALIFORNIA: Cal set a season high in big plays (20 yards or more from scrimmage) with eight in the 49-7 win at Oregon State. Five of the plays came in the first half, which tied the Bears' full-game high entering the contest ... **Chase Garbers** started at quarterback and completed 17-of-26 passes for 234 yards and 3 TDs ... Cal's defense allowed a season-low 241 total yards - the lowest ever under head coach Justin Wilcox ... The Bears set a season high with 7.0 sacks ... A trio of Bears posted 10 tackles each - **Jordan Kunaszyk**, **Evan Weaver** and **Tre Turner III** ... RB **Patrick Laird** rushed 22 times for 193 yards and 2 TDs. It was his sixth career 100-yard game and his first of 2018. Laird's rushing yards are the second highest of his career, surpassed only by his 214 yards (on 33 carries) vs. Oregon State last season. He added 3 catches for 48 yards and 1 TD in tallying 241 all-purpose yards in the win.

WASHINGTON STATE (6-1) at STANFORD (5-2)
Sat., Oct. 27 • 4:00 pm PT • P12N • #WSUvsSTAN

WASHINGTON STATE: With six wins, the Cougars are bowl-eligible for the fourth consecutive season (first time in WSU history) ... For the first time since 1981-84, the Cougars have defeated Oregon in four consecutive seasons ... WSU held Oregon to 58 total rushing yards, the second lowest total the defense has allowed this season ... QB **Gardner Minshew II** has thrown for 300-plus yards in seven straight games, completing 39-of-51 for 323 yards and 4 TDs in the win ... The Cougars lead the FBS in passing offense with 400.7 yards per game ... WSU has 13 rushing TDs this season, after rushing for 8 TDs last season ... WSU has won 11 straight home games for the first time since 1928-33 (school-record 19 game-winning streak). The 10 straight is the 3rd-longest in program history.

STANFORD: Sophomore CB **Paulson Adebo** recorded his first career interception in the 20-13 win at Arizona State. He ranks No. 2 nationally with 16 total passes defended and his 15 break ups lead the FBS ... Junior QB **K.J. Costello** has posted three 300-yard passing games this season. The last Cardinal quarterback to accomplish the feat was Andrew Luck in 2011, when he did it five times ... Senior WR **JJ Arcega-Whiteside** had seven receptions for 91 yards and 1 TD. He ranks third nationally -- and first among Pac-12 players -- with nine receiving touchdowns ... Senior WR **Trenton Irwin** has at least one reception in 35 consecutive games, a streak that ranks eighth nationally. He added to that when he matched his career-high with seven receptions for 79 yards at Arizona State.

OREGON (5-2) at ARIZONA (3-5)
Sat., Oct. 27 • 7:30 pm PT • ESPN • #UOvsAZ

OREGON: QB **Justin Herbert** has thrown a TD pass in 22 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the nation ... Herbert hasn't thrown an interception on the road in Pac-12 play in 205 consecutive passing attempts, dating back to his final attempt of the game at Cal on Oct. 21, 2016. Has thrown for 1,770 yards with 17 TDs to just one INT in eight career conference road games ... WR **Dillon Mitchell** posted his fourth straight game with at least seven receptions (7 rec., 47 yards). Over the last four games, he has 36 catches for 510 yards and 2 TDs. He has a catch in 12 straight games, with 58 catches for 870 yards and five TDs over last nine games ... DB **Deommodore Lenoir** became the third different Duck with two interceptions in a game this season ... LB **Kaulana Apelu** posted a career-high 14 tackles in the loss at WSU (most by an Oregon player since Joe Walker had 15 vs. USC on Nov. 21, 2015).

ARIZONA: WR **Shawn Poindexter** had six catches for 106 yards and 2 TDs in the 31-30 loss at UCLA. It marked his first career multiple-touchdown game and second career 100-yard receiving game ... RB **J.J. Taylor** finished with 154 yards on 19 carries for his fifth-career 100-yard rushing game and second this season. The 154 yards are the third-most in Taylor's career ... Sophomore RB **Gary Brightwell** rushed for a career-high 121 yards on 15 carries. It's Brightwell's second-career 100-yard rushing game ... Arizona had a 100-yard rusher and a 100-yard receiver in the same game for the first time this season ... Sophomore QB **Rhett Rodriguez** got his first start of the season and responded by going 15-of-34 for 231 yards, two TDs and two INTs.

However, in 2018-19, if the Pac-12 champion is ranked among the top four of the CFP poll following the 2018 season, it would play in either the Orange or Cotton Bowl. The Rose Bowl would then replace the Pac-12 Champion with another Pac-12 team.
