Colorado Head Coach Mike MacIntyre

"First of all, USC is a very good team, very experienced, very athletic. We did a good job against the run. We gave up too many big plays against the pass. We made some fundamental errors. Our offense kept battling. Any time we got momentum we got a holding penalty. We couldn't establish the run very well early. But a couple of those penalties hurt us. I thought the kids kept battling and fighting. I thought it was a physical game. I was pleased the way our front 7 played. We won the turnover battle and the penalty battle and you should have a chance to win the game. We kind of had a chance but just shot ourselves in the foot."

On two-point conversion attempt

"We got totally screwed up on that and I'll take the blame for that."

On not using his timeouts at the end of the first half.

"They had just scored we were kind of on our heels. Last year, we had thrown a pick six at the end of the half. So we were a bit cautious so we didn't have a turnover again. We got in an area where I thought we could throw a Hail Mary. We were a little cautious so we didn't turn the ball over like last year."

On CU's defense

"I've got to do a better job with them. I've got to keep working and going and this is definitely disappointing. We didn't play as well as we would like but USC had a lot to do with that. Here or there we could have made some plays and not had some called back that were our fault, it could've been a closer ending."

On USC's defense against CU's short passing game

"They did a great job. They were breaking down hill and dropped 8 a lot. They were doing some things they hadn't done. They had a week off and were interchanging out of the same personnel group. We started finding some stuff that would work, but it was too late.

"I thought the front 7 played well and physical. The secondary didn't play as well as we would have liked but they're going to have to."

On JT Daniels

"He put the ball on the money and was able to hold it a few times. We were right there a few times but couldn't make the play. (We) had (some) interference calls. They challenged us and had a good scheme. They had good rout runners and a kid who could make all the throws."

Colorado QB Steven Montez

On USC's defense

"I think they had us figured out. When we had some of the play calls and had some good calls, maybe we shot ourselves in the foot. It was a bunch of different penalties. We need to clean it up."

"They took away our short passes and short intermediate game and we were having some trouble running the ball. They made us throw it outside. Once we got it going, we were making some positive plays."

"They're a damn good football team. They don't play any games. They're a good football team."

"It was important to give us a little bit of confidence. I still think we've got to get it going earlier. Getting it going in the second half is not cutting it. "It's always tough to deal with a loss after a promising first half of the season. The way we'll take it is as a positive and a learning experience. They're down (in the locker room), but they're heads are up, looking forward to Washington."

HEAD COACH CLAY HELTON

Opening Statement

"Glory to God and a bunch of great kids for getting a great victory at the Coliseum. Appreciate the fans for coming out and the support. It was a really good win for our team. It's a win that allows us to control our destiny the rest of the way, it gives us first place and we have the opportunity now to move on to Utah and prepare for that game. I thought defensively it was a tremendous effort, I think any time you have 16 tackles for a loss in a game, it just felt like the defense was playing in that Colorado backfield all night. From a rush standpoint, we put a huge point of emphasis on putting pressure on the quarterback. Offensively we saw a lot of pressure tonight. I thought Mike Pittman had an unbelievable night as well as the rest of our receivers. They big play after big play and really got us some separation going in and halftime."

On Palaie Gaoteote IV and Reuben Peters' performances:

"I think the bye week helped develop some young kids who we knew they were going to have to help us. EA [Palaie Gaoteote] got his opportunity and was the leading tackler today. He came in and really got to the ball and played very instinctively. And the rest of our defense played that way as well. It was Reuben's turn as well and he's trained for this moment for a long time. He's a kid who walked on here, earned a scholarship and played really well for us on special teams. He came in to finish the game off and did a really great job getting us in the right calls."

On the defense without Cameron Smith:

"I was very proud of them. I thought we were playing in their backfield the entire night. Whether it was run game, pass game. Their quarterback had a night where he was having to get off his spot consistently and just interrupt his timing. Tremendous plan by Clancy (Pendergast) and the defensive staff. I credit Johnny Nansen and Kenechi Udeze for a great job with what they're doing with that D-line."

On JT Daniels' development through the game:

"JT settled in nicely. He got fooled on the first pass. We knew we wanted to be aggressive in the ball game. We knew we were going to have to take shots. We kind of had a feeling they were going to try and pressure us, plus they played so much man coverage and adding safeties to the box, that we thought we were going to have to go up top. So it was a heavy shot game. We didn't hit all of them, we missed a few in the second half, but when we were able to get them, our defense took over and did the job."

On the defense's improvement from week one to week seven:

"We knew coming in that our defense would have to help us if we wanted to win a Pac-12 title. I agree with Pittman — I think we're making strides. It was neat to see the quarterback have a couple mistakes and then settle in. It wasn't perfect, but he was putting the ball into the right people. We have some things to work on. But he settled in really nice and found the one-on-one matchups and he believed in his guys to make the plays, and that's all you can ask for as a coach."

On if the defense playing well helps offensive struggles:

"In the first quarter both defenses were doing their job. There were a couple three-and-outs for both teams early. And then we settled in and rattled off 21 points, a lot which were on explosive plays down the field. Tee recognized it offensively and said we were going to have to take some shots. We cut it loose and trusted our kids to make the plays and they did."

On handling Colorado QB Steven Montez:

"He's hard to contain. We came in saying we had to do a great job tackling on the perimeter. When you look at them in the first 20, 30 plays they're a perimeter team. Our kids just tackled extremely well. Not a lot of missed tackles tonight. I think it was our best pursuit of the ball tonight. That's what you have to do against guys like him. The first guy misses and the next guy has to be there to make the play."

AJENE HARRIS, CB

On coming to USC from Crenshaw HS and getting the interception:

"It's a blessing to come here. It's always been my dream school, and to play with Helton and the guys is amazing. I got the pick and I was trying to find the ball and bring it over to coach."



MICHAEL PITTMAN, JR, WR

On offensive takeaways from this game:

"I feel like the offense is taking steps as far as making those explosive plays. I feel like we showed some good things moving forward."

On if the defense playing well helps offensive struggles:

"Whenever they play well it makes me and the offense want to help them out. Help them carry the load and take some of that weight off of their shoulders and puts some points up. They played lights out today, and gave us chances to score points."

On what the matchup was like with Colorado's defense:

"To my understanding Colorado has never beaten SC so that's what fuels it. I'm not going to be the guy that lets them beat us."

On if this was a breakout game:

"I don't like the term breakout. I feel like every game I become ready to make our plays. I feel like that's what we did as a team, is made our plays. I feel like we still have room to work. But we're showing signs of positivity and that we can make those plays. It's a good boost for us."

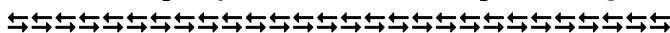

Colorado sold its entire ticket allotment for this game (3,000) ... The Buffs had won three straight games dating back to 2014 when wearing gold helmets/white jerseys/gold pants ... USC now leads the series by a 13-0 count (7-0 in Los Angeles) ... This marked the third time CU had a lead versus USC since the Buffs joined the Pac-12 in 2011: CU led 7-0 in '11, 17-3 in '15 and tonight... When USC took a 21-7 lead late in the first half, it marked the first time that

CU trailed by two scores in 2018 ... Of the 73 plays in the first half, only 13 were in plus territory (USC 8, CU 5) ...

Player One Liners. CB Chris Miller made his first career start ... WR Jaylon Jackson saw his first career action (the 42nd player to do so for CU this season), and also made his first career receptions ... Colorado has scored in 20 of 24 quarters this season ... PK James Stefanou is now 61-of-61 for his career in PAT kicks ... S Kyle Trego recovered CU’s onside kick; the Buffs had not recovered one for the previous six tries (including one in this game), as WR Nelson Spruce recovered the last one at Oregon in 2014.

Scoreless First Quarter. The scoreless first quarter in tonight’s game was just the ninth involving the Buffaloes over the last 196 games (dating back to 2003) ... but the second season in a row with the Trojans.

Interceptions. ILB Drew Lewis made his first career interception on the first play of the game; it was CU’s fourth pick of the year, all by linebackers at that point. The secondary then got its first later in the quarter when S Evan Worthington had the fourth of his career.

Strength vs. Strength: Colorado came in allowing just 3 points in the fourth quarter (best in the nation); USC came in with 39 fourth quarter points (47th). Winner: Colorado won the quarter, 13-3, meaning CU has yet to allow a fourth quarter TD. CU outgained the Trojans 101-22, and over the last two games CU has outgained the opponent 198-25 with 22:36 of possession time.

Turnover Streak Ends. Ajene Harris’ interception in the third quarter ended a run of 11 straight quarters by the Buffs without committing a turnover; it also ended a streak of 83 consecutive passes by QB Steven Montez without throwing a pick, his third streak of 80-plus in his career.

INDIVIDUAL LINER NOTES

WR Laviska Shenault (9-72 receiving; 2-46, 1 TD rushing)

► Before leaving with a foot injury, he improved his numbers to 60 receptions for 780 yards (13.0 per) in six games; his streak of one receiving TD in five games came to an end (it tied for the second longest streak in CU history, two short of the record), but his career-long rush of 49 yards for a score extended it overall to six games (11 TDs on the season).

QB Steven Montez (47-26-1, 170 passing; 9-9 rushing, 1 TD)

► With 179 yards total offense, he moved into fifth on CU’s all-time list with (6,285), passing Tyler Hansen (6,183, 2008-11).

- USC improved to 13-0 all-time against Colorado and has scored 30 or more points in eight of those games.
- USC extended its home win streak to 19, currently the second-longest home winning streak in the nation.
- Fr. QB **JT Daniels'** finished with 272 yards passing tonight. He was 17-for-34.
- Daniels' 255 first-half passing yards were the most in the first half at USC since Sam Darnold threw for 263 yards against Penn State in the 2017 Rose Bowl. It was also more yards than in three of Daniels' first five starts and the most allowed by Colorado in an entire game so far this season.
- Daniels' 28-yard, 65-yard and 9-yard TD passes in the second quarter give him seven this year, the 65-yard pass a season-high, this game marking his second multi-TD pass game this year.
- Jr. WR **Michael Pittman Jr.** had career high with 2 TD catches and finished with 144 receiving yards, 2 off his career best of 146 vs. Stanford in the 2017 Pac-12 Championship game. Tonight he had a career-long 65-yard TD reception in the 2nd quarter and a 9-yard TD catch on the next drive.
- Pittman Jr. now has a team-high 3 TD catches this year.
- So. WR **Tyler Vaughns'** 28-yard TD catch was his 2nd this year. He finished with 5 catches for a season-best 86 yards.
- Fr. ILB **Palaie Gaoteote**, in his second career start, recorded his first career TFL on USC's second defensive series. He finished with nine tackles and 2 TFLs before leaving the game in the third quarter.
- Sr. DB **Ajene Harris** recorded his third career interception returned for a TD, which ties a school record shared with Charles Phillips (1972-74) and Nickell Robey (2010-2012).
- So. DL **Liam Jimmons** recorded his first career sack in the 2nd quarter.
- Harris also had 2 TFL in the 1st quarter, matching his career high in a game (2016, Notre Dame).
- SR. OLB **Porter Gustin** recorded his team best 6.5 sack in USC's first defensive series. He added a half sack in the 3rd quarter to give him 7 this year.
- Jr. ILB **Jordan Iosefa** recorded his first sack and TFL of the season in the 4th quarter.
- Sr. ILB **Cameron Smith** missed his first game tonight (hamstring) since missing the final four games of his 2015 freshman season (knee)
- USC entered the game with 27 TFLs and had 9 in the first half and finished with 16 overall. That is the most tackles for a loss in a game by the Trojans since also having 16 vs. San Jose State in 2009. The last time USC had more tackles for a loss in a game was when it had 19 vs. California in 1997.
- CU's 111 first-half yards was an opponent low for USC.
- Colorado was shut out in the first quarter for the first time this season, its seven first-half points were a season low and its 20 total points were a season low.
- USC has held 4 of its 6 opponents to 21 points or less.
- Colorado was held to 265 yards tonight. The Buffaloes entered tonight averaging 490.6 yards of total offense per game, 18th nationally.
- The 265 total yards were the fewest by a USC opponent since holding Utah State to 253 the second game of the 2016 season.
- The 31 points scored by USC are a Colorado opponent high this season. Colorado entered tonight's action allowing 18.4 points per game, 21st nationally.
- Fr. TB **Markese Stepp** had his first two career rushing attempts which totaled 10 yards.
- USC had 13 penalties for 123 yards. In its last two games, USC has had 31 penalties for a total of 292 yards.
