### ARIZONA NOTES & NUMBERS

» Saturday's showdown between Arizona and Colorado comes on the heels of three consecutive Wildcat wins in the head-to-head series. The Wildcats are 8-14 all-time against Colorado, losing the first 12 head-to-head meetings between the two programs from 1931 to 1985. Arizona has won both meetings in the series under head coach Kevin Sumlin; 42-34 in 2018 and 35-30 in 2019.

» The Wildcats dropped the 27-10 decision at UCLA on Saturday as true freshman Will Plummer saw his first collegiate action after Grant Gunnell was injured on the first play from scrimmage. Plummer completed 17-of-35 passes for 151 yards while rushing for 49 yards.

» Stanley Berryhill III was one of eight different Wildcats to catch a pass against the Bruins and finished with team highs of five catches and 58 yards. Included in those 153 receiving yards by eight Cats was Drew Dixon's first half catch of 28 yards, besting his previous career high of 24 yards versus UCLA in 2019.

» The Arizona defense stymied the Bruins early, allowing just three first-quarter points. It marked the sixth time during the Kevin Sumlin era that the Wildcats defense has held an opponent to three or fewer points in the first quarter.

» Entering Saturday, 12 different Wildcat receivers have caught at least one pass through the first three games. Six of Arizona's 12 receivers with at least one catch are averaging over 10 yards per catch.

» Arizona has reduced its passing yards surrendered by nearly 100 yards each game this season after allowing 325 yards through the air to USC, 239 by Washington and 129 to UCLA. The 129 passing yards surrendered marked the eighth time in the last decade the Wildcats have held a Pac-12 opponent to fewer than 150 yards passing in a game.

**7** Arizona's **seven** wins over Colorado since the Pac-10 grew to 12 in 2011 are the program's most over any conference foe during that span, followed by the Wildcats' four wins over California and Utah.

**377.0** The Wildcats have averaged **377.0** passing yards in their two wins over Colorado under head coach Kevin Sumlin.

**27** Junior offensive lineman Donovan Laie has started in **27** consecutive games entering Saturday's game versus Colorado. He's just outside the top 10 of the program's longest starting streaks by an offensive lineman since Arizona began tracking starts in 1993.

**11,735** The Wildcats have rushed for **11,735 yards** since 2016, the best mark in the Pac-12 Conference. Arizona has led the conference in rushing three times over that stretch, and are one of just two teams (also: Oregon) with a rushing total north of 11,000 in the last four-plus years.

**66.2** Sophomore quarterback Grant Gunnell's career completion percentage entering Saturday's game is **66.2%**.

**SOME GAME THEMES:**

- The Arizona offense continues to show its explosive prowess with nine plays of 20 or more yards in its first two games against two of the Pac-12's top defenses in USC and Washington with two more explosion plays versus UCLA. The Wildcats have tallied a total of 11 offensive plays of 20 or more yards in the first three games this season after recording 12 plays of 20 yards or more on offense against Pac-12 defenses in all of 2019.
- Sophomore Christian Roland-Wallace recorded a career-high 10 tackles in the loss to UCLA on Saturday. The defensive back is on pace to eclipse his freshman mark of 37 total tackles in 12 games as the Palmdale, California native has 15 through the first three games of the shortened 2020 season.
- Senior defensive back Lorenzo Burns enters Saturday's showdown with the Buffs with 38 career starts as a Wildcat. His 38 starting nods trail only Oregon's Jordon Scott (41) for the most among all active Pac-12 players.
- Wildcat kicker Lucas Havrisik has shown his powerful leg on kick offs. He has neutralized opposing return units this season as only one of his 15 kickoffs has been returned.
- With over 60 percent of its roster made up by underclassmen, Arizona has seen XX different players make their career starts through the first three games of the 2020 season.
- The Wildcats' hold a 10-game losing streak entering Saturday at Colorado and dating back to 2019, which is tied for the program's longest winless streak since the 1956 and 1957 seasons. Arizona ended 1956 with a pair of losses, tied BYU in the 1957 opener, and then lost seven straight games. The 2016 Wildcats lost their first eight Pac-12 games of the season before winning the Territorial Cup.

**VERSUS COLORADO:**

- The Wildcats will face the Buffaloes on Saturday in a series that has seen Arizona win seven of the nine meetings between the two programs since Colorado joined the Pac-12 in 2011. The Cats have won the last three meetings courtesy of their offense that has averaged 40.7 points per game in those three victories.
- Arizona's 35-30 win last season came was powered by a passing attack that amassed 400 yards with eight receivers and backs on this year's roster catching at least one pass.
- Wide out Brian Casteel starred in last year's meeting, finishing with 7 catches for 74 yards and a touchdown. His seven receptions still stand as a career high.
- Since the Wildcats and Buffaloes became conference foes in 2011, Arizona has averaged 39.0 points per game in all nine match-ups. The Cats' seven victories during that span have come by an average margin of 12.9 points per game.
- Colorado head coach Karl Dorrell spent five seasons as the head coach at UCLA from 2003 to 2007, posting a 2-3 record against Arizona with both of his wins coming in Tucson during the 2005 and 2007 seasons.

**CHARTING THE CATS (CAREER):**

- Redshirt senior defensive back Lorenzo Burns has notched nine career interceptions in four seasons, putting him just three picks shy of breaking into the Wildcats all-time top 10 leaderboard.
- Burns is also on the verge of cracking into Arizona's career top 10 in pass breakups. Through four years he has picked up 25 PBU, just three shy of tying Trevin Wade (2008-11) and Randy Robbins (1980-83) for 10th all-time.

**GRANT LAND:** Sophomore quarterback Grant Gunnell entered the 2020 season as the Wildcats clear-cut No. 1 signal caller after splitting time during his freshman campaign with Khalil Tate. Gunnell's collegiate debut came in blowout duty against Northern Arizona in week two of 2019; he threw for 151 yards and three touchdowns on 9-for-11 passing. His first career start came in game four, the Wildcat's Pac-12 opener against UCLA – in the game, Gunnell completed 29-of-44 pass attempts for 352 yards, one touchdown, and no interceptions while leading Arizona to a 20-17 victory. effort against UCLA earned him Pac-12 Freshman Player of the Week honors. He also saw playing time against Washington, at USC, at Stanford, against Oregon State, at Oregon, and against Utah. When it was all said and done, Gunnell threw for 1,239 yards, nine touchdowns, and suffered just one interception on 101-of-155 passing in his freshman campaign. His 65.2% completion percentage ranks fourth all-time in Arizona program history with a minimum of 100 attempts and was the best ever effort by a freshman passer. Prior to the season, Gunnell was selected as one of five Arizona captains – he is the only underclassmen among the five captains.

**FAB FIVE:** Grant Gunnell built a prodigious opening to his career through his first five starts with the Wildcats. Across his first five starts behind center, Gunnell went gone 98-for-149 passing for 1,075 yards and seven touchdowns with just one interception. His 1,075 yards are the most by an Arizona QB through their first five starts since Anu Solomon opened his career with 1,741 yards through the air. Even more impressive is Gunnell's sparkling 65.8% completion percentage, which stands as the best mark by a Wildcat passer in their first five starts since Nick Foles posted a mark of 72.3%. Gunnell has tallied 200+ yards three times in five starts and passed the 200-yard mark in two of his three starts this season.

**I'M MR. BRIGHTWELL:** After two years of serving the Wildcats as an effective backup running back, senior Gary Brightwell finally gets his time in the spotlight as Arizona's primary tailback in 2020. He opened the year with a 112-yard performance against No. 20 USC, giving him four career 100-yard rushing performances and putting him over the 1,000-yard career mark. He has also added pass catching to his repertoire in 2020, pulling in eight receptions for 34 yards during the Wildcats first three games after logging just six catches for 59 yards in his first three seasons. During his time in Tucson, Brightwell has always been productive, averaging 5.5 yards per carry and 30.0 yards per game. His five touchdowns in 2019 were a career high after scoring three times during his sophomore years in 2018. Brightwell's biggest career game to date on the ground came against Northern Arizona last season, as he rushed for 141 yards on just five carries. Included in his NAU onslaught was a 94-yard rushing touchdown, the longest of his career and tied for the second-longest rush in school history (also: Nic Grigsby, 2009, NAU). The next week against Texas Tech, Brightwell posted his first career multi-score game after going for 85 yards and two touchdowns on 21 carries. He also scored twice against Oregon State, with one of his touchdowns coming through the air for his first career receiving touchdown.

**IN A RUSH:** Despite doing much of their damage through the air recently, Arizona's rushing attack still remains dangerous. The Wildcats finished the 2019 season third in the Pac-12 with an average of 174.0 yards per game on the ground. Prior to that, the Wildcats had strung together four consecutive years of averaging north of 200 yards per game rushing. Arizona's ability to run the ball often ties to the success of the team. Over the past five seasons, when the Wildcats have rushed for 200 or more yards, the team has posted a record of 26-11. In games where Arizona hasn't reached the 150-yard mark as a team, they are 6-20. The Wildcats have led the Pac-12 rushing scene since the start of the 2016 season and is one of only two programs to top 11,000 yards in that span (also: Oregon).

**INSTANT IMPACT:** Redshirt sophomore wide receiver Jamarye Joiner impressed for the Wildcats in 2019, ultimately leading the receiver corp with 552 yards and five touchdowns through the air in his first go-around at the position. The Tucson native and Cienega High School product joined the Wildcats in 2018 as a quarterback and made the transition to wide receiver during Arizona's 2019 fall camp. In his first collegiate action at wideout against Hawai'i in week one of 2019, Joiner pulled in four receptions for 72 yards and his first career receiving touchdown. His best outing of last year came at Arizona State in the Territorial Cup, in which he pulled in career highs in receptions (7), yards (140), and touchdowns (2). His 140 yards against the Sun Devils were the most by an Arizona receiver since Cayleb Jones had 182 versus New Mexico in 2015. Joiner also reeled in touchdowns against Washington and Stanford last year. Joiner immediately impacted the Wildcats again in 2020, wasting no time and pulling in two receptions for 42 yards and a touchdown against USC in the season opener.

**THE PANDY MAN CAN:** Senior linebacker Anthony Pandy steps into a leadership role for the Wildcats defense in 2020 after three years of steady improvement. He is expected to serve as Arizona's primary "Will" inside linebacker in first-year defensive coordinator Paul Rhoads' new base 3-4 scheme. During his three-plus-year career to date, Pandy has tallied 120 total tackles, 11.0 tackles for loss, four sacks, and one interception. The best season of his career came in 2019, his junior campaign, during which he collected 66 tackles, five tackles for loss, and two sacks while playing in all 12 games. Pandy's 66 tackles in 2019 are the most among all of Arizona's returning defensive players. The best tackling performance of his career came against Utah last season – in a home game against the Utes in 2019, Pandy notched a career-high 11 tackles.

**SPEED KILLS:** Senior wide receiver Tayvian Cunningham has put his wheels to good use in Tucson, establishing himself as the primary speed threat among the Wildcats talented receiving corps. Of his three career touchdowns, two have come from further than 45 yards out — his average touchdown catch in Tucson has clocked in at 43.3 yards. Cunningham's average mark of 16.1 yards per reception this year is the best mark among Wildcat receivers. He transferred to Arizona after two years at Sacramento City College, where he competed in both football and track. In 2019 Cunningham hauled in 35 receptions for 383 yards and two touchdowns – he also saw time in five

**ZO SAYS NO:** Redshirt senior defensive back Lorenzo Burns is the Wildcats most experience secondary player, having seen time in 40 games with 38 starts since 2016. Last season he was named the Wildcats Team Defensive MVP and earned Pac-12 All-Conference Honorable Mention recognition after tallying 47 tackles, four interceptions, and seven pass breakups across 12 starts at cornerback. Burns' four interceptions led the team and were tied for the most by a single Pac-12 player. He currently boasts nine career interceptions, putting him three shy of breaking into the programs all-time top 10 leaderboard. Burns is also just three pass breakups short of breaking into the Arizona top 10.

**NEW ROLE, SAME JALEN:** Redshirt junior linebacker Jalen Harris is making the transition from a "hand in the ground" pass rush specialist to full-time outside linebacker under Arizona's new defensive coordinator Paul Rhoads. He was the Wildcats leading returner in both tackles for loss (6.5) and sacks (4.0). During three-plus seasons and 31 games in the cardinal and navy, Harris has compiled 71 total tackles, 13.0 tackles for loss, 7.0 sacks, and one forced fumble. Harris played in all 12 of the Wildcats games in 2019 with eight starts on the defensive line and notched multiple tackles in seven different games. He began thriving instantly in his new role in 2020, posting career-best marks in tackles (6) and tackles for loss (2.0) in the Wildcats season opener against USC. He then passed his mark in tackles and reset his career high with seven stops on the road at UCLA.

**BRIGHTWELL NAMED TO DOAK WALKER AWARD WATCH LIST:** Arizona rising senior running back Gary Brightwell was named to the Doak Walker Award Watch List, the PwC SMU Athletic Forum announced in July. The Doak Walker Award recognizes the top running back in the nation. As a junior last year, Brightwell played in 11 of 12 games, teaming up with fellow running back J.J. Taylor to form a dangerous one-two punch in the backfield. Brightwell finished his junior campaign with 66 carries for 390 yards and five touchdowns. He averaged 5.9 yards per carry and had a 94-yard touchdown run against Northern Arizona, which tied for the second-longest run in school history. For his career, Brightwell has 915 rushing yards and eight touchdowns on 157 carries, averaging nearly six yards per carry in his three years with the Wildcats. The National Selection Committee consists of past recipients, former NFL All-Pro and college All-America running backs, media members and selected special representatives. The award is named for SMU's three-time All-America running back Doak Walker. It is the only major collegiate award that requires all candidates to be in good academic standing and on schedule to graduate within one year of other students of the same classification.



**MCCAULEY NAMED TO RIMINGTON TROPHY WATCH LIST:** Arizona senior Josh McCauley has been named to the 2020 Fall Watch List for the Rimington Trophy, which honors the top center in college football. McCauley was a member of the distinguished watch list last season as a junior as he started all 10 games he appeared in at center for the Wildcats. The Mesa, Arizona native has amassed 22 starts coming into the 2020 season with 25 career appearances. McCauley has anchored an offensive line that has guided one of the top rushing attacks in the Pac-12 in each of the last two seasons as Arizona has finished in the top three of the conference in rushing in each of those seasons. The Wildcats have also eclipsed 2,000 yards rushing in each of McCauley's two seasons as the team's center. Arizona's everyday starting center joined the program as a walk-on and was awarded a scholarship by head coach Kevin Sumlin on the day of the 2019 Spring Game.

**STRONGER TOGETHER:** Arizona Athletics has launched its "Stronger Together" campaign focused on social injustice, which is led by student-athletes. Centered around the pillars of solidarity, empowerment and respect, the athletics department is supporting "Stronger Together" as part of its ongoing diversity and inclusion initiatives. The campaign represents a student-athlete-driven unified branding message on racism, social injustice, and equality. The name itself, Stronger Together, was created and discussed as a theme and motto by Arizona's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC), which is made up of representatives of all 21 programs in the department. The student-athletes on SAAC held an open discussion about the motto in collaboration with the department's Inclusive Excellence Council to emphasize the student-athletes' desire to use Stronger Together as the singular message for all NCAA-approved jersey patches, social media content and messaging points. Arizona Football has chosen to continue the conversation with their Stronger Together helmet stickers throughout the 2020 season.

**BURNS, LAIE EARN PRESEASON PAC-12 HONORS:** Arizona defensive back Lorenzo Burns and offensive lineman Donovan Laie have earned Preseason All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention for the 2020 season, as voted on by the conference's media. The honor from the Pac-12 Conference is the first preseason award for both Wildcats while Burns earned an All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention following the 2019 season. Burns, a senior from Oceanside, California, has been an everyday fixture at cornerback for the Wildcats with 35 career starts entering the season. He enters the 2020 season as the second most experienced returner in the Pac-12, trailing Oregon's Jordon Scott whose amassed 37 career starts. Burns has tallied 9 interceptions in his career to go along with 34 pass break ups and 168 tackles. With three interceptions this season, Burns would enter Arizona's top-10 career mark for picks. Junior Donovan Laie has anchored Arizona's offensive line, starting in all 24 of Arizona's games since arriving on campus in 2018. He's bolstered an offensive line that has made Arizona the only program in the Pac-12 to finish in the top three of the league in passing and rushing yards per game in each of the last two seasons. Laie earned a spot on the Pac-12 Fall Academic Honor Roll as a sophomore.

**STATE 48:** The Wildcats roster features 30 players that call the state of Arizona home, including eight players who stayed home in Tucson to continue their football careers. Arizona's 30 in-state players make up over 25% of the total roster. Among the notable Arizona natives are redshirt sophomore wide receiver Jamarye Joiner, graduate transfer defensive linemen Aaron Blackwell and Roy Lopez, redshirt junior wide receiver Drew Dixon, redshirt junior linebacker Jalen Harris, redshirt senior offensive lineman Josh McCauley, and sophomore offensive lineman Jordan Morgan. **WILDCATS IN THE NFL:** Coming into week 12, the Wildcats are once again well represented in the National Football League with 10 former letterwinners active across the league. One of Arizona's most prestigious alums, tight end Rob Gronkowski, returned from retirement to rejoin his longtime quarterback Tom Brady with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers. Over nine season in New England, Gronkowski hauled in 7,861 yards and 81 touchdowns – he caught his first touchdown for the Bucs in week six and has since hauled in three more. Quarterback Nick Foles is in his ninth NFL season after rewriting the Wildcats record books during his time in Tucson. Now with the Chicago Bears, Foles has been the team's starting QB since week four. The most recent Wildcats to make the transition to the NFL are running back J.J. Taylor and defensive back Jace Whittaker. Taylor was a mainstay in the Arizona backfield from 2016-19 and has since taken his talents to New England. Whittaker finished his Arizona career ranked fourth-all time in pass breakups and was recently promoted to the Arizona Cardinals active roster. ## RECAP

**BOULDER, Colo. (AP)** -- Khalil Tate threw for 404 yards and three touchdowns in his return from a leg injury and Arizona used stops at the goal line and midfield on Colorado's final two drives to wrap up its 35-30 win on Saturday.

Tate completed 31 of 41 passes and only ran four times, including a 7-yard scamper on third-and-6 from midfield in the closing minutes that allowed Arizona (4-1, 2-0) to run out the clock and leave Folsom Field as the Pac-12 South's last unbeaten team.

The Buffaloes (3-2, 1-1) sorely missed star receiver Laviska Shenault (core muscle injury), who sat out, as well as safety Mikial Onu, who had a first-half interception but left on the first defensive series of the second half with a torso injury.

Without him, the Buffs surrendered three second-half touchdowns after taking a 20-14 halftime lead.

The Wildcats weren't whistled for a penalty until the final play of the third quarter - offside - during the Buffaloes' longest drive of the day, a 14-play marathon that stalled with Colorado failing to score on three plays from inside the Arizona 5.

They settled for James Stefanou's 20-yard field goal and a 30-28 lead.

That stall proved costly when the Wildcats responded with Nathan Tilford's 5-yard TD run that put Arizona on top 35-30 with 6:51 left.

The Buffaloes drove to midfield and converted a fourth down but on third-and-4 from the Arizona 46, quarterback Steven Montez didn't recognize two open receivers on slant routes up the middle when the Wildcats blitzed two linebackers. Instead, he overthrew a receiver on a go-route.

His fourth-down throw to Dimitri Stanley was too high and Arizona took over at with 2:23 remaining, then sealed the win on Tate's 7-yard keeper with less than a minute left.

Tate threw TD passes of 33 yards to Brian Casteel, 75 yards to Cedric Peterson and 7 yards to Stanley Berryhill III.

Montez completed 28 of 42 passes for 299 yards and a TD with Tony Brown catching 10 passes for 141 yards, and Stanley four for 75 yards and a touchdown.

The Buffaloes were whistled eight times for 85 yards in penalties and the Wildcats just once for 5 yards.

- Khalil Tate's 404-yard performance through the air was the 18th 400+ yard passing game by an Arizona quarterback in school history, and the first since Anu Solomon threw for 520 yards against California on Sept. 20, 2014.
- With 3 touchdown passes against Colorado, senior QB Khalil Tate claimed sole possession of third place all-time for the Wildcats with 52 touchdowns through the air. He finished the game 31-for-41 passing with a career-high 404 yards (previous high: 361 at Hawai'i 8/24/19).
- Junior linebacker Colin Schooler finished the game with eight total tackles, one of which was a tackle-for-loss. He now has 254 career stops and is just the 24th player in Arizona history to log 250+ career tackles. With his 1.0 TFL, Schooler is 0.5 TFL away from breaking into the Wildcats all-time top 10.

Kevin Sumlin, a three-time national Coach of the Year finalist, was named Arizona's 32nd head coach on Jan. 14, 2018. He was formally introduced at a press conference on Jan. 16.

Sumlin comes to Arizona after serving as the head football coach at Texas A&M University for six seasons (2012-17), compiling a 51-26 record including three bowl victories. He also served as the head coach at the University of Houston for four seasons (2008-11), amassing a 35-17 record. In his 11 seasons as a head coach, Sumlin has compiled an 91-50 record and his teams have played in bowl games in nine of those seasons.

During his time at Texas A&M, Sumlin averaged over eight victories per season and won at least seven games each year, while competing in what many believe to be the toughest division in college football, the SEC West. His 44 wins over his first five seasons in College Station marked the second-fastest coaching start in school history, behind R.C. Slocum's 49 wins from 1989-93. Sumlin was the first Aggie head coach to lead his first six teams to a bowl game, and Sumlin's teams improved the Aggies' school record streak of consecutive seasons with a bowl game appearance to nine. His three bowl victories are tied for the most in school history. In addition, Sumlin guided Johnny Manziel to a stellar freshman season that saw him throw for 3,419 yards and 24 TDs, while running for 1,181 yards and 19 TDs en route to the 2012 Heisman Trophy.

Sumlin was hired at Texas A&M after a successful stint as head coach at the University of Houston. His final Cougar squad set a school record with 13 victories (12 prior to Sumlin's departure to Texas A&M) in 2011 and notched the program's highest finish in the Bowl Championship Series standings. He was named the Region 5 Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association that year and was one of five finalists for the AFCA's National Coach of the Year award. Sumlin guided the Cougars to berths in the 2011 Ticket Center Bowl and the 2008 and 2009 Bell Helicopter Armed Forces Bowls.

Sumlin went to Houston after seven seasons as an assistant coach and offensive coordinator in the Big 12. He spent five seasons at the University of Oklahoma under head coach Bob Stoops, where he served as both the co-offensive coordinator/wide receivers coach (2006-07) and special teams coordinator/tight ends coach (2003-05).

Before his arrival in Norman, Sumlin spent two seasons at Texas A&M under head coach R.C. Slocum, where he served as the assistant head coach, offensive coordinator and wide receivers coach for the Aggies (2001-2002).

Sumlin's coaching career has also seen stops at his alma mater Purdue (1998-2001), Minnesota (1993-97) and Wyoming (1991-92).

## RECAP

**TUCSON, Ariz. (AP)** - Vavae Malepeai bulled his way through multiple tacklers for an 8-yard touchdown run with 25 seconds left, and No. 20 Southern California beat Arizona 34-30 on Saturday with another late rally.

USC (2-0, 2-0 Pac-12) was outplayed by Arizona State last week before scoring two touchdowns in the final three minutes to win 28-27.

The Trojans again had two late scoring drives to win a game they were outplayed in for most of the afternoon.

Kevon Slovis hit Erik Krommenhoek on a 6-yard touchdown, but Arizona (0-1, 0-1) marched quickly down the field for a 6-yard touchdown pass from Grant Gunnell from Stanley Berryhill III with 1:20 left.

Slovis, off target early, completed four straight passes for 68 yards and Malepeai capped the 75-yard drive by carrying several Arizona defenders with him into the end zone.

Slovis threw for 325 yards and a touchdown on 30-of-43 passing.

Gunnell threw for 286 yards and three touchdowns for Arizona, which played its first game in nearly a year after last week's opener against Utah was canceled due to the coronavirus.

The sophomore entered the 2020 season as the starter after sharing time with Khalil Tate last year and had a streak of 92 straight passes without an interception. The streak nearly ended on his first pass against USC and then did on the second, when he overthrew a receiver into Talano Hufanga's arms.

That set up Markese Stepp's 1-yard TD run.

Gunnell was much better on the next drive, hitting Jamarye Joiner on a short pass that turned into a 34-yard touchdown.

Arizona kept churning out yards — 231 by halftime — but had to settle for three field goal attempts. Lucas Havrisik made two and USC led 17-13 at halftime after Stephen Carr scored on a 3-yard run with 2 1/2 minutes left.

Arizona tied it at 20 when Gunnell hit Tayvian Cunningham in stride for a 75-yard touchdown reception early in the third quarter.

USC struggled in the red zone early in the second half.

Amon-Ra St. John pulled down a spectacular 48-yard catch, but the Trojans stalled and settled for Parker Lewis' 28-yard field goal. Stepp ripped off a 49-yard run on the next drive and USC marched down to Arizona's 1-yard line. Consecutive penalties back the Trojans up and Lewis pushed a 28-yard field goal wide right.

Another drive into the red zone, another trip without points. This time, Arizona stopped the Trojans on fourth-and-1 from the Wildcats 4.

Havrisik gave Arizona its first lead at 23-20 with a 51-yard field goal midway through the fourth quarter.

## RECAP

**SEATTLE, Wash. (AP) --** Dylan Morris threw for 230 yards and two touchdowns, Washington got rushing touchdowns from three different running backs, and the Huskies routed Arizona 44-27 on Saturday night.

Washington (2-0) was thoroughly dominant, jumping to a 24-0 halftime lead and led 37-0 before Arizona finally found the end zone early in the fourth quarter. For a while, it appeared the Huskies could be in line to post their first Pac-12 shutout since a 30-0 win over Washington State in the 2009 Apple Cup, but the Wildcats feasted on Washington's backup defense in the fourth quarter.

While the Huskies defense stifled the Wildcats for three quarters, it was Morris and the Washington offense that showed efficiency and explosiveness that was absent in last week's opening win over Oregon State.

It started on the opening drive when Morris hit Puka Nacua on a 65-yard catch-and-run touchdown. He added a 20-yard TD pass to Cade Otton midway through the third quarter to give the Huskies a 37-0 lead. And in between, the Huskies got TD runs from Kamari Pleasant, Sean McGrew and Richard Newton.

Newton added a second TD early in the fourth quarter on a 54-yard run.

Morris finished 15-of-25 passing and his numbers would have been significantly higher if not for a handful of dropped passes. His TD strike to Nacua was his first career TD pass, but his favorite target was Otton. The Huskies talented tight end had a career-high seven catches for 100 yards.

Arizona (0-2) lost its ninth straight game dating back to last season — a streak that started with a home loss to Washington — and took a step back from last week's loss to USC.

The same offense that rolled up more than 400 total yards and scored 30 points on the Trojans managed just 66 yards through three quarters against Washington. Arizona didn't have a pass play longer than 14 yards until a 30-yard TD catch by Stanley Berryhill III early in the fourth quarter. For the first three quarters, Arizona averaged just 1.8 yards per play.

Arizona quarterback Grant Gunnell was 27 of 39 for 259 yards and three touchdowns, almost all of those numbers coming in the fourth quarter against Washington's reserves. He was sacked five times, twice by Zion Tupuola-Fetui.

Gary Brightwell was held to 55 yards rushing after having 112 last week against USC.

## RECAP

**PASADENA, Calif. (AP)** — Demetric Felton rushed for career-high 206 yards and a touchdown, Brittain Brown added two scores and UCLA defeated Arizona 27-10 at the Rose Bowl Saturday night.

Felton is the 15th player in UCLA history to post a 200-yard game and the first since Joshua Kelley did it against USC in 2018. The senior, who finished with 230 scrimmage yards, had 134 rushing yards in the first half, including a 1-yard touchdown midway through the second quarter to extend the Bruins lead to 17-7. Felton also had a career high in carries with 32.

Brown, a graduate transfer from Duke, added 72 yards on 16 carries, including a 2-yard touchdown late in the fourth quarter to put the 2-2 Bruins up by 17.

Redshirt freshman Chase Griffin started his second straight game and completed 12 of 20 passes for 129 yards and a touchdown. Griffin got the start due with Dorian Thompson-Robinson being held out due to COVID-19 contract tracing.

Arizona starter Grant Gunnell suffered a shoulder injury on the first play when he was tackled by UCLA linebacker Bo Calvert, who came in unblocked on a blitz. Freshman Will Plummer came in for his first collegiate action and had 164 scrimmage yards. He went 17 of 35 for 151 yards passing and two interceptions along with 12 carries for 113 yards.

The Wildcats (0-3) have lost a program-record 10 straight games dating back to last season.

The Bruins scored 20 straight points after Arizona took a 7-0 lead on Michael Wiley's 3-yard run. After Nicholas Barr-Mira made the first of his two field goals, UCLA took a 10-7 lead with 11:58 remaining in the first half when Brown took a short pass over the middle from Griffin, broke three tackles and scored from 16 yards out.

The Wildcats drove inside the UCLA 10 twice in the second half but their only points came on Lucas Havrisik's 26-yard field goal late in the third quarter. Arizona attempted a fake field goal during the fourth quarter but holder Jacob Meeker-Hackett bobbled the snap, scrambled right and was forced out of bounds at the UCLA 8 for a 1-yard loss.

## RARE LEAD

Wiley's touchdown gave the Wildcats a first-quarter lead for only the fourth time in 13 road games during coach Kevin Sumlin's three-year tenure.

The Wildcats had a short field to work with after Felton was stopped for a 3-yard loss by Jalen Harris and Trevon Mason on fourth-and-1 from the UCLA 22.

## THE TAKEAWAY

Arizona: Gunnell's injury marked the fourth time in the last five years that a Wildcats starting quarterback has been hurt going into or during the UCLA game. Coincidentally, Gunnell's first start came last year against the Bruins when Khalil Tate couldn't play due to a hamstring injury.

UCLA: The Bruins defense came in leading the conference in sacks (10) and tackles for loss (27) but weren't able to take advantage of a struggling Arizona offensive line. UCLA finished with two sacks and four tackles for loss.
