## QUICKLY

The 90-degree temperature at kickoff marked the 20th game in school history of 90 or hotter at kick; CU is 10-10 in these games) ... The Sun Devils now lead the series by 9-3 margin, including a 6-1 dg in Tempe and 6-4 in night games ... CU is 5-6 in Pac-12 conference openers (3-2 on the road) and are 83-43-2 all-time in conference openers ... CU had 63 yards of total offense last week against Minnesota (45 plays); it took 16 plays tonight to accumulate that total (first play of second quarter) ... CU did not commit a fumble for the third time in four games this season (all four came last week versus Minnesota) ... CU has now scored 80 of its last 82 times in goal-to-go situations (63 TD/17 FG) over the course of its last 54 games ... CU had no turnovers for the second game this season (also: UNC) and now has three in 10 games under Karl Dorrell (5-5 record).

**Scoreless Streak Over.** Cole Becker's 51-yard field goal ended a run of eight straight scoreless quarters (137:11 in time).

**First Action as Buffaloes.** One player saw his first action in a CU uniform tonight: **TB Noah Wagner** (on special teams; he's the first-ever Buffalo from Conifer, Colo., High School).

**Colorado Hall of Fame Celebrations Abound.** Tonight, the Colorado Rockies at Coors Field celebrated **Larry Walker's** induction into the Baseball Hall of Fame; this Saturday, CU will honor **Michael Westbrook's** induction into the College Football Hall of Fame with an in-game ceremony at Folsom Field. CU hosts Southern California in a Noon kickoff (Pac-12 Networks).

### TB Jarek Broussard (12-35 rushing)

► He became the 56th player in CU history to record 1,000 career rushing yards (1,001), doing so in his ninth game, the fastest of all Buffalos to do so; **Charlie Davis** ('71-73) previously hit th mark in 10 games. (*Reminder: CU dos NOT include bowl stats and will not until the NCAA counts all bowl games. This is to protect history.*)

### PK Cole Becker (2-3 FG, 51 long)

► He made the first two field goals of his career (after missing from 53, 46 and 46 yards;

### ILB Nate Landman (8,2—10 TT; 4 TZ)

► If his numbers hold up in coaches review, it will be the 21st double-digit career tackle game of his career (fifth-most at CU); H has 39 career TFLs, but now has 33 tackles for zero gains with four tonight; that's 72 tackles at or behind the line of scrimmage. H would pass NT Laval Short ('76-79) into seventh place on CU's all-time tackles list with 380 and remains fourth in solo stops:
