## **QUICKLY**

- ▶ **Records.** USC now leads the series a **15-0** count (8-0 in Boulder, 7-0 in Los Angeles) ... The Buffaloes are now **24-31-1** all-time when wearing all black uniforms (**0-5** vs. USC) ... CU has won four of five coin tosses this year, and dating back to 2016, **41** of the last **61** ... Heading into the season's only bye week, the Buffs are **30-24** following a bye since World War II (**4-6** since joining the Pac-12).
- ▶ Weird Stat of the Game. The bulk of the yards in this game came on second down conversions: CU gained 158 yards on its 11 second down makes, while USC had 168 on its second down conversions.
- ▶ **This-N-That.** Five "new" NFL teams scouted the game today, bringing the total to **23** that have seen CU games in person in 2021 ... Colorado has run just **288** plays on offense through five games (57.6 per; high of 64 in the opener against UNC; the last time CU didn't have a game with at least 70 plays in the first five of a season was in 2006, and before that, 1986) ... **S Trustin Oliver** celebrated his 20th birthday today ...

FIRST CAREER STARTS CB Nigel Bethel, Jr., and ILB Jack Lamb made their first career starts as Buffaloes; DT Mustafa Johnson made his first start of the season in the first game he became eligible.

**PENALTIES** The flags were flying today, particularly against USC: the Trojans were penalized 12 times for 125 yards. It was the most penalties by an opponent since USCX had 13 in the 2018 game and the most yards since Arizona had 129 later than same season.

#### Individual liner notes

## TE Brady Russell (3-87 receiving)

- ▶ He had career-highs for yards (87) and long reception (65), topping his previous bests of 77 and 34, respectively, against UCLA last year. It was just the second time since 2012 that a tight end has led the Buffs in a game in receiving yards, and he had the other (5-77 vs. UCLA in 2020). It matched the most yards by a Buff tight end in a game also since 2012, when Nick Kasa caught three passes for 87 yards in CU's 35-34 win at Washington State, and the most in a home game since Oct. 20, 2007 (Tyson DeVree, 7-90 and a TD in a 19-14 loss to Kansas).
- ▶ He now has 42 career receptions for 463 yards, as he cracked CU's top 100 in the latter (ending the game 89th on the list).

### ILB Nate Landman (7,2-9 TT; 1 TZ)

▶ His march to 400 tackles and the sixth to achieve that many in CU history continues; if his numbers hold up in coaches review, he will have 389 for his career (274 solo, 115 assists), and he will have passed Rick Gamboa (389; 2015-18) into sixth all-time. He thus would trail just the five with 400.

#### **OB Brendon Lewis (17-10-1, 162, 1 TD, 146,5 rating)**

- ▶ He threw for a career high 162 yards, and posted the best QB rating of his career as well.
- ▶ Both his career interceptions have come on tipped passes.

#### P Josh Watts (7-49.6 avg., 2 In20, 1 TB; 43.1 net, 56 long)

► He continues to have a run of career games; for the season, he now has 31 punts for 1,512 yards, a 48.8 average (with 14 of his last 28 punts traveling 50 yards or longer).
