## QUICKLY

- **Records.** Oregon State retook the lead in the series by a **7-6** count, evening the series in Corvallis at **2-2** and **5-11** in the state of ORwgon ... Colorado is now **3-4** under interim head coaches (**1-1** under Mike Sanford).
- **Number 9.** This marked just the **eighth** time in 1,286 all-time games CU finished a game with **9** points; last was a 17-9 loss at Missouri in 2004.
- **First by the Foe.** Oregon State was the first team to return a kickoff against the Buffaloes this year (2-46, 23.0).
- **Birthday Boys:** QB J.T. Shrout turned 23 today; WR Jaylon Jackson (turning 24) and TB Jayle Stacks (turning 20) will click over to their new ages on the United Airlines charter ride home.
- **Second Half High.** The 190 yards in the second half was a team-high this season for after intermission (old: 187 at Minnesota). The 129 fourth-quarter yards were second to the 136 against the Gophers.
- **Tonight's Special Teams Captain:** ILB Mister Williams.
- **First Action As A Buff.** One player saw his first action as a Buffalo: TB Dante Capolungo (*moved to offense from defense this week due to the injuries*).

## INDIVIDUAL LINER NOTES

### WR Jordyn Tyson (3-92, 30.7 avg., 1 TD, 2 FDE))

- Recorded a career-high in yards with his 58-yard reception the longest play from scrimmage this year for the Buffaloes.
- His **92** receiving yards are the sixth-most by a true freshman in CU history:
- 141** (11 receptions), Paul Richardson vs. Kansas at Lawrence, Nov. 6, 2010.
- 121** (5 receptions), Paul Richardson vs. Iowa State in Boulder, Nov. 13, 2010.
- 103** (2 receptions), Josh Smith vs. Baylor at Waco, Oct. 6, 2007.
- 94** (1 reception), Jeremy Bloom vs. Kansas State in Boulder, Oct. 5, 2002.
- 94** (5 receptions), Shay Fields vs. Arizona at Tucson, Nov. 8, 2014.
- 92** (3 receptions), Jordyn Tyson vs. Oregon State at Corvallis, Oct. 22, 2022.

### ILB Josh Chandler-Semedo (4,7-11 TT, 4 3DS, 1 TFL, 1 PBU)

- If numbers hold up under coaches review, has his career-high for tackles as a Buffalo.
- He recorded four third down stops (three on third down, one on fourth—both count under the 3DS column)—a CU season-high – and the 19th time in school history a player had four (the record is 5, by Carson Wells versus Oregon State in Boulder last year).

### TB Jayle Stacks (8-50, 1 TD, 4 FDE, 19 long)

- Had career-highs in all categories, including scoring his first collegiate touchdown.
