

Football-Basketball Buffs

Through the years, there have been several players who suited up for both CU's football and basketball teams. But since World War II, only three scored points in both sports: **Don Branby** (1950-53), who was reserve on the basketball team, **Dave Logan**, who lettered four times in each sport (1972-75); he scored 817 points on the court and 36 on the gridiron; and **Brian Johnson** (1977-81), who scored 840 points in hoops and 2 in football—he caught a two-point conversion pass against BYU in 1981.
