

Since 1950, CU has averaged 5.2 yards on the first play from scrimmage. Of the 72 plays for 370 yards, CU has passed 16 times (completing 12). CU has not scored on the first play from scrimmage in this time frame, and has just one turnover (lost fumble) on the first play of the year (in 1990; *—at Anaheim; #—in Denver).

NOTE—CU did score the first time it touched the ball in the 1975 season opener. Mike McCoy returned a California punt 61 yards for a touchdown two minutes into the game.

DID YOU KNOW?...The last time Colorado scored on its first offensive play of any game was at Arizona on Nov. 8, 2014: Shay Fields scored a touchdown on a 75-yard pass from Sefo Liufau just 11 seconds into the game in Tucson. That was the first time since 1996.

NOTES—Twelve players have recorded CU's "first score of the year" on two occasions, but no one has done it three times (three quarterbacks have thrown two TD passes on the first score of the year). The only known time in school history that the Buffaloes have scored on the first a player touched the ball came in 1975, when **Mike McCoy** returned a punt 61 yards for a touchdown against California in Boulder (sans the kickoff). In 2016, **C Alex Kelley** became the first offensive lineman to score CU's first points of the year (fumble recovery). *—first points scored in school history (touchdowns were worth 4 points in 1890).
