

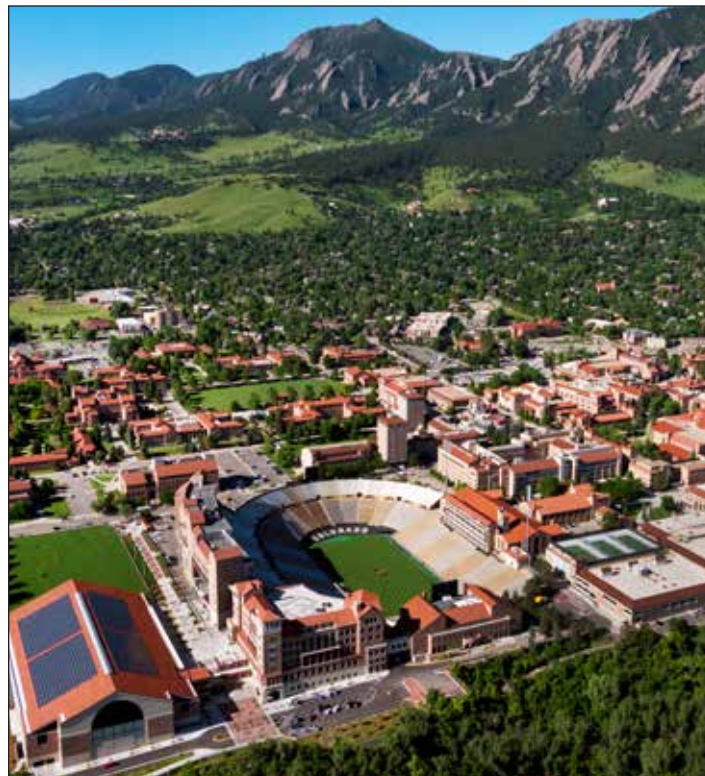

THE TOP CROWD EVER AT FOLSOM?... It was for a rock concert, not a football game. On May 1, 1977, for one of the popular Colorado "Sun Day" concert series, 61,500 turned out to see Fleetwood Mac, Bob Seger, Firefall and John Sebastian. Folsom has played host to many top national recording acts, including The Rolling Stones, The Who, Paul McCartney, The Eagles, Van Halen, REO Speedwagon, The Beach Boys, The Grateful Dead, The Doobie Brothers, Journey, Jethro Tull, John Mellencamp and the Dave Matthews Band.



CU's all-time record at Folsom Field through 2021 is 324-181-10 (.639). *—The COVID-19 pandemic allowed a limited number of fans only for the opener.
