## Shedeur Sanders

### Shedeur Sanders Makes Plays in All Situations

Shedeur Sanders' impact can't alone be explained by surface level stats, and when you look at clutch situations, a clearer understanding of his impact truly unfolds.

Starting off games Shedeur is one of the best in the first quarter. He is second in the country with a completion percentage of 80.2 %. In the first 15 minutes of games he is fourth with 10 touchdown passes. Wrapping all the stats into one he is ranked third in passer rating of those who have completed at least 70 passes with a 179.39 QB rating.

When a drive and a game need a big play to be made on third down, Sanders is at the top of the list of quarterbacks you want making the decisions. On third downs Shedeur is 61-of-98 (.622) for 964 yards good for third in the nation and 10 touchdowns tied for second among all QB's. It's not just that he is completing passes and moving the chains, on third down Sanders leads the nation in passes of at least 25 yards with 12. Making the right decisions leads him to the third highest QB rating among quarterbacks with at least 50 completions.

Getting more into the details of what makes him stand out among the rest of the nations quarterbacks, in third- and 1-3, he completes 10-of-12 (.833) passes for 146 yards and four touchdowns. His touchdowns (4) is second in the nation and his QB rating (295.53) is the top mark. When teams load the box expecting a run, Sanders finds ways to complete passes and convert them to touchdowns.

In all situations Sanders completes passes at an extremely high clip. He is leads the country on first down with at least 100 attempts, first against conference opponents, second in wins for those that are bowl eligible, second in road/neutral site games with at least 100 attempts, second when the game is tied, and third in the month of October. No matter what the game brings, he continues to stay calm and complete passes and move the chains.

He is also great when the Buffs are trailing by one score, hitting on 77-of-107 (.720) passes for 1,021 yards which leads the NCAA, with eight touchdowns making him fourth in the country and two interceptions with a QB rating of 173.04. He is third in throws of 25 yards or more with 11 and his QB rating is second of those with at least 50 completions.

In all situations Shedeur is one of the best, that holds true with his completion percentage of 73.4 leads the country, while his passing yards per game at 327.2 is good for third in the NCAA.

## Shedeur Sanders

### Shedeur One Of Six With 11,000 Yards Since 2021 In Division I

Shedeur Sanders is one of six quarterbacks in DI ball, counting both FBS and FCS, to throw for more than 11,000 yards in the past four seasons. His 132 touchdowns are the most in the nation and his PFF pass grade of 92.8 is one of five over 90 combined in the four seasons with at least 1,000 attempts and tops among the six with 11,000-plus yards. ### Shedeur Sanders Had One Of Best Seasons In School History

QB Shedeur Sanders turned heads in the 2023 season, particularly through the first half of the season. He finished the season in the top 10 in four major statistical categories and in the top 25 in three others. At the time of his injury, he led the nation in receptions per game at 27.1 and finished second, leading the Pac-12. He finished fourth nationally in passing yards (314.4, second in the league), eighth in completion percentage (69.3, third), 12th in passing touchdowns (27, fourth), 18th in total offense (286.6, fifth) and 24th in pass efficiency (151.7, fifth). His 9.0 touchdown/interception ratio was fourth best in the nation behind Oregon's Bo Nix (15.0, 45-3), Penn State's Drew Allar (12.5, 25-2) and LSU's Jayden Daniels (10.0, 40-4).

In terms of CU records, his 3,230 yards, 0.7 interception percentage, 9.0 touchdown/interception ratio, 151.7 quarterback rating and 69.3 completion percentage are all new school marks, and his 298 completions and 430 pass attempts both rank second all-time.

### Awards Season

Hunter won the 90th winner of the Heisman Trophy and was on 93.32% of ballots, which is the fourth highest in the history of the award. Hunter is the first player to win both the Biletnikoff Award, given to the top receiver regardless of position and the Bednarik, best defensive player in college football history.

### Players With 50 Receptions, 3 INTs

Against Utah in 2024, Hunter caught his fourth interception of the season giving him his second season with at least 50 receptions and three interceptions. Last season he became the first player in at least the last 25 years in FBS to accomplish this. Champ Bailey was the only other player to have at least 40 receptions and three interceptions in a season.
