**ABOUT THE BUFFALOES:** Colorado is 8-4 overall claiming a pair of wins in a span of about 56 hours this last week after a week-long break from finals. The Buffaloes defeated Fort Hays State 81-71 on Dec. 17, turning around two days later with a 75-68 triumph at the Air Force Academy. The Buffaloes have won four of five and six of their last eight including victories over ranked Xavier and Texas squads.

Colorado is averaging 75.1 points per game while shooting 44 percent from the field. The Buffaloes are coming off their second-best shooting performance of the season hitting 54 percent at Air Force. Colorado hit double-digits in 3-point field goals for the second time this year, hitting 10-of-24 for 41.7 percent. The Buffaloes had been just 13-of-51 the previous two games from 3-point range (.255).

Defensively, Colorado has held the opposition to 66.7 points per game and 38.2 percent shooting. The Buffaloes are third in the Pac-12 Conference in 3-point defense (.299) while ranking fourth in overall field goal percentage defense and total rebounding (40.5 rpg).

Depth and balance have been a key for Colorado. Three Buffaloes are averaging double-digits in scoring while five more are averaging between five and eight an outing. Four players have at least four rebounds per game while six are in double-digit assists. Colorado had five players score in double-digits against Air Force. The Buffaloes are 6-0 this season when four or more players reach double figures in the points column.

Senior **Derrick White** is averaging 14.8 points, 3.9 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game while hitting a team-best 52.2 percent from the field. He was the Pac-12 Player of the Week after averaging 22.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.5 assists in games against Xavier and BYU. White shot 55.2 percent from the field overall (16-of-29) while hitting 6-of-12 from 3-point range.

He was named to the Legends Classic All-Tournament team averaging 18.0 points, 5.5 assists and 5.0 rebounds, shooting 54 percent against Notre Dame and Texas. He scored 20 points and dished out a team-season high nine assists against the Fighting Irish. The nine assists are the most by a Buffalo since Askia Booker had 12 against UCLA on Feb. 13, 2014. White had a team-high 16 points with 5 rebounds, 2 assists, 2 steals and 2 blocks against Texas.

White is ninth in assists, 12th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.4), 13th in free throw percentage (.796), 15th in blocks (1.2 bpg) and 16th in scoring on the Pac-12 charts.

**Xavier Johnson** tops the team in scoring - by one point over White - at 14.9 points per game while ranking third in rebounds at 6.1 an outing. He had a game-high 14 points against Air Force, scoring in double figures for the fifth-straight game, sixth in his last seven and ninth overall. Johnson had 18 points and seven rebounds in the win over Xavier, hitting 7-of-11 from the field including 3-of-4 from 3-point range. His second 3-pointer against the Musketeers was the 100th of his career. Johnson has made 27 of his last 50 field goal attempts (.540).

He averaged 19 points over three-game span which included the Legends Classic and Wofford, putting in a pair of 20-point performances. Johnson matched a career high with a team season-best 27 points against Wofford. He also had a season-high 12 rebounds against the Terriers, logging his seventh career double-double. Johnson had a game-high 23 points in the Legends Classic semifinal against Notre Dame.

Johnson ranks 13th in 3-point percentage (.406), 15th in scoring and 19th in rebounding on the Pac-12 leaderboard.

**George King** is third on the team in scoring at 11.3 points per game and second in rebounding at 7.5 per contest. King recorded his fourth double-double of the season and fifth of his career with 14 points and 12 rebounds at BYU. It was his second straight double-double after his 16-point, 10-rebound effort vs. Xavier. His four double-doubles this season have come in the last nine games. King just missed an-

other double-double with 13 points and nine rebounds at Air Force.

King had a fantastic Legends Classic, recording back-to-back double-doubles and averaging 14.5 points and 13.0 rebounds over the two-day series. He tallied a personal-best 13 rebounds in both contests. King scored 17 points against Notre Dame while pitching in 12 in the win over Texas. He had 10 rebounds in the first half alone against Texas.

King is 11th in defensive rebounds (5.8 drpg) and 14th in overall rebounds on the Pac-12 leaderboard.

Guard **Josh Fortune** is Colorado's fourth leading scorer at 8.6 points per game. He had a season-high 15 points in the win over Fort Hays State. Fortune broke out of a prolonged shooting slump hitting 5-of-9 from the field including 3-of-6 from 3-point range. Prior to making his first 3-pointer against the Tigers, he had missed 16 straight shots including nine from beyond the 3-point arc.

Fortune leads the Pac-12 in free throw shooting at 89.2 percent, hitting on 33-of-37 attempts. He saw his consecutive free throws made streak end at 19 against Portland. That streak included a perfect 10-of-10 game against ULM, the program's best performance without a miss since Askia Booker was 14-of-14 against DePaul on Dec. 22, 2014.

**Wesley Gordon** tops Colorado in rebounding at 8.4 per game. Gordon is pitching in 6.8 points per game while leading the squad in blocks (21) and ranking third in assists (26). He had a team season-best five blocks at Air Force; he had four in the first half alone which was better than his previous team season-high of three. He's tallied 18 of his blocked shots in the last eight games and ranks second on CU's all-time list at 177.

Gordon registered his fourth double-figure scoring game of the season with 10 at Air Force and first since his season-high 11 points vs. CSU. He tied a season-high with four field goals made and had his most efficient performance of the season at 80 percent. He has made 6-of-8 over his last two games.

On the Pac-12 charts, Gordon is fifth in offensive rebounding (2.8 orgp), eighth in blocks (1.8 bpg), ninth in overall rebounding and 12th in defensive boards (5.6 drpg).

**Dominique Collier** returned to the lineup against Air Force after missing the previous nine games with a foot injury. He had nine points against the Falcons hitting 3-of-6 from 3-point range. Collier is averaging 7.0 points over his three games played, hitting 53 percent from 3-point range. He had a team-high 12 points in the opener against Sacramento State, hitting 4-of-6 from deep.

Sophomore **Thomas Akyazili** is second on the team in assists (2.3 apg) while scoring 2.9 points per contest. He made his first 3-pointer of the year at BYU, snapping an 0-for-11 slump. He dished out four assists, recording his third game of the season with four or more. Akyazili dished out a career-best six assists in the season-opener against Sacramento State.

Junior **Tory Miller** is fourth on the team in blocks (5) and sixth in rebounds (3.1 rpg) while pitching in 5.6 points an outing. Miller had nine points with a season-high five free throws made against Fort Hays State. He had a season-high 10 points against ULM, the ninth double-figure scoring game of his career. He also added his first career 3-pointer (in five attempts) against Sacramento State.

Colorado's freshman class, with a wealth of experience in front of them, have picked their spots to contribute. As a group they are av-

eraging 10.1 points and 4.4 rebounds per game. **Deleon Brown** has 25 points in the last two games, including a career-best 15 against Fort Hays State. He had just 33 points over his first 10. He has made 7 of his last 12 field goal attempts and 4-of-8 from 3-point range. **Bryce Peters** played a personal-best 21 minutes off the bench at BYU with three points, two rebounds, and assist and a steal. **Lucas Siewert** scored for the first time in five games with five points at BYU. He's averaging just under two rebounds per game.

**TICKETED FOR REDSHIRT:** The Buffaloes are planning to redshirt two freshmen. **Dallas Walton**, a 7-0 forward and **Alexander Stratting** a 6-7 forward. Walton earned All-Jefferson County Conference first team honors for Arvada (Colo.) West High School in 2015-16. Stratting hails from the Netherlands and played for the Canarias Basketball Academy in Spain last year.

**Namon Wright**, a 6-5 guard, will sit out the 2016-17 season after

transferring from Missouri and will have two years of eligibility remaining. He averaged 8.2 points and 3.8 rebounds and made 79 3-pointers in 61 games with the Tigers.

**ABOUT THE EAGLES:** Eastern Washington is 8-4 overall and in the middle of a tough four-game road trip. The Eagles had won eight in a row before dropping their first two of this current road swing including Tuesday's 85-56 setback at Xavier. Eastern Washington is averaging 77.0 points per game while shooting 45 percent from the field and 79 percent from the free throw line. EWU is also an excellent shot blocking team, averaging 5.6 per game, ranking 28th in the nation. Defensively, Eastern Washington gives up 78.8 points per game while allowing opponents to shoot 46 percent.

Junior guard/forward Bogdan Bliznyuk is averaging 20.6 points per game while shooting 50 percent from the field. The two-time Big Sky Conference Player of the Week, Bliznyuk is among the nation's leaders in minutes played (37.9 mpg) and free throw percentage (.909). Senior forward Felix Von Hofe is third on the team in scoring at 13.8 points while leading the Eagles with 39 3-pointers made. Senior forward Jacob Wiley tops Eastern Washington at 7.6 rebounds per game while pitching in 13.9 points an outing. Wiley ranks among the national leaders in blocked shots at 3.3 per game.

Jim Hayford is in his sixth season at Eastern Washington with a record of 92-83. He is in his 18th overall season as a collegiate head coach with a record of 346-167.

**THE SERIES:** This will be the third meeting between Colorado and Eastern Washington with the Buffaloes winning both previous contests; both in Boulder. Colorado defeated the Eagles 87-67 on Dec. 2, 1994 and 79-61 on Dec. 18, 1999. The Buffaloes are 37-25 all-time against teams that currently make up the Big Sky Conference with the bulk of those coming against Northern Colorado (CU leads 20-18).

Tad Boyle is 4-4 as a head coach against Eastern Washington, all eight games coming while he was at Northern Colorado. Jim Hayford has never faced Colorado as a head coach.

**RIGHT AT HOME:** Colorado has won 14 of its last 15 and 24 of 26 in the friendly confines of the Coors Events Center.

The Buffaloes had a streak of 14-straight home wins against non-league opponents snapped in the loss to Colorado State. When Pac-12 play begins, Colorado will bring an eight-game win streak against league opposition at home, tied for the 12th best run in team history.

In the **Tad Boyle** era, Colorado is a sparkling 94-16 at the Coors Events Center (.855). The Buffaloes are 407-167 (.709) all-time at the CEC, picking up win No. 400 in style as Colorado defeated No. 9/10 ranked Arizona 75-72 in front of the third-largest crowd in facility history (11,309) on Feb. 24, 2016.

**GRAND ACHIEVEMENTS:** **Xavier Johnson** became the 33rd player to score 1,000 points at Colorado on Nov. 14, but two other players are recording unique milestones of their own.

Senior **Derrick White** reached the 2,000-point mark for his collegiate career during the Colorado State game. White scored 1,912 points in three seasons at UCCS (2012-15). Senior Josh Fortune needs 65 points to reach 1,000 in his collegiate career. Fortune scored 481 points in two years at Providence College (2012-14) and has 454 in 45 games at Colorado.

**4 OF A KIND:** Colorado sports an unusual occurrence with four fifth-year seniors on its roster, each traveling a different path to get

to this point.

**Wesley Gordon** has taken the most traditional five-year route. He took a redshirt season his true freshman year as Colorado was loaded in the front court led by Andre Roberson currently with Oklahoma City of the NBA. Gordon is among Colorado's all-time leaders in rebounds and blocked shots.

**Xavier Johnson** played his first three seasons (2012-15) before an Achilles injury derailed his 2015-16 season. Johnson has been a steady performer, averaging double-digits over his three years and joining the 1,000-point club on Nov. 14 against Seattle U.

**Josh Fortune** is the mid-career transfer. After two years at Providence College, helping the Friars to the 2014 Big East title, Fortune transferred to Colorado and sat out the 2014-15 season. He was

a key contributor to Colorado's NCAA Tournament run as a junior ranking third on the team in scoring.

**Derrick White** will get his one-year shot in Boulder this year. White played his first three years at NCAA Division II UCCS, earning All-America honors. He practiced with the Buffaloes last year as a redshirt.

Additionally, the Buffaloes also have a fourth-year junior in **George King**, the reigning Pac-12 Most Improved Player of the Year.

**BOYLE WINNING PERCENTAGE: Tad Boyle** has hovered right around the school's all-time winning percentage lead since the early portion of the 2015-16 season (minimum two seasons), Boyle, who has won 62.6 percent of his games with Colorado (139-83), is just ahead of CU Athletic Hall of Fame coach Forrest "Frosty" Cox who was 147-89 (.623) in 13 seasons between 1936-50. Boyle is 195-149 in his 11th year as a collegiate head coach.

**IN THE POLLS:** Colorado received votes for the six straight week in the USA Today Coaches Top 25 Poll on Dec. 12. The Buffaloes received votes in the first four Associated Press polls.

Eight 2016-17 opponents have been or are currently ranked in one of the Top 25 polls including Oregon, UCLA, Arizona and Xavier who have each made a Top 10 appearance this year. Texas was ranked in both polls before dropping out Nov. 28. California had a one-week run at No. 25 in the AP poll. No. 21/21 Notre Dame debuted in the Dec. 5 edition of both polls. No. 24/25 USC earned its initial ranking this week.

**AGAINST RANKED TEAMS:** Colorado has won two straight and three of its last five against ranked opponents. This is the first season with two wins over ranked teams since 2013-14 (2-6 overall).

The Buffaloes have back-to-back wins against ranked opponents for the first time since winning three straight in February-March 2013: Feb. 7 at #19/19 Oregon (48-47), Feb. 14 vs. #9/9 Arizona (71-58), March 7 vs. #19/25 Oregon (76-53).

With its win over No. 13/14 Xavier, Colorado defeated its highest ranked nonconference opponent since its 75-72 win over No. 6/7 Kansas on Dec. 7, 2013. Colorado claimed a win in its first game against a ranked opponent this season with its 68-54 win over No. 22/21 Texas on Nov. 22. It was Colorado's first win over a ranked opponent away from Boulder since a 76-53 win over No. 19 Oregon on March 7, 2013.

Colorado's 14 wins over ranked opponents in Boyle's six-plus seasons is by far the best streak in team history. In fact Boyle coached teams, with a record of 14-24, have accounted for 24 percent of wins over ranked opponents (58) since 1949-50.

**FOR OPENERS:** Colorado improved to 90-24 all-time in home openers and has won its last nine, making Boyle a perfect 7-0 in home openers. The Buffaloes have won 14 of their last 15. Colorado is 79-35 (.693) in all-time season openers. The Buffaloes are 5-2 under Boyle. The Buffaloes are 32-5 in overall season openers since the 1980-81 season.

Colorado's 90 points against Sacramento State were its most in a season opener since defeating Cal Poly 97-69 to begin the 2002-03 season. The 37-point margin of victory in a season-opener tied for the largest in team history, matching only a 54-17 win at Denver on Jan. 29, 1903, the second season of the program.

**LONG WAIT OVER:** Two Colorado seniors made their long-awaited

debut at the Coors Events Center in the season opener.

**Xavier Johnson** had six points, seven rebounds and a pair of assists, making his return after missing the 2015-16 season due to a torn Achilles tendon in his left leg.

**Derrick White** had nine points and four assists in his Colorado debut. He sat out last after transferring from UCCS. He was an NCAA Division II All-American for the Mountain Lions averaging 22.0 points, 5.9 rebounds, 3.9 assists and 1.6 steals over his three-year UCCS career.

**HIGHLY RANKED TRIO HEADED TO BOULDER:** What could be the best men's basketball signing class in the Tad Boyle era at the University of Colorado was made official on Nov. 9 as **Evan Battey**, **Tyler Bey** and **D'Shawn Schwartz** inked their National Letters of Intent to join the Buffaloes for the 2017-18 season.

Rivals.com rates Colorado's class the 16th best in the nation while Scout.com has the Buffaloes at 18th. Scout considers all three signees four-star recruits. Schwartz and Bey are also four-star players according to Rivals.

Highly regarded as the top player in Colorado, Schwartz is a 6-6, 210-pound wing from Colorado Springs. He averaged 19.9 points and 8.5 rebounds as a junior at Sand Creek High School, earning Class 4A All-State Second Team honors. Schwartz is a two-time All-Pikes Peak Athletic Conference First Team pick and back-to-back runner-up for that league's Player of the Year honor.

Bey, a 6-7, 205-pound small forward, is a Las Vegas native attending

Middlebrooks Academy in Los Angeles. He's rated as the 27th best small forward in the nation by Scout and third in the state of California. Rivals rates him in their Top 150 as the 114th best overall player.

Bathey, a 6-8, 275-pound forward, hails from the Los Angeles area and was an All-Orange County and All-Crestview League selection for Villa Park High School in 2015-16. He averaged 24 points a game for the Spartans and rated as the third best post player in the state of California. ESPN ranks him as California's ninth-best overall prospect.

**BUFFS FIFTH IN PRESEASON POLL:** Colorado was picked to repeat its 2015-16 Pac-12 Conference finish as the Buffaloes were selected fifth in the annual media preseason poll.

Colorado earned 199 points, 10 shy of fourth place California. The Buffaloes were 10-8 in the 2016 final league standings.

Defending champion Oregon was picked to repeat its title with 320 points and collecting 23 of 27 first place votes. Arizona received the other four first place votes and were second with 298 points followed by UCLA in third (259).

After Colorado, Washington was sixth (167) followed by USC (163), Utah (142), Oregon State (122), Stanford (119), Arizona State (78) and Washington State (30).

**2017 PARADISE JAM:** While the 2016-17 season is just underway, a piece to the 2017-18 season is already in place. Colorado will be one of eight teams participating in the Paradise Jam, Nov. 17-20, 2017, in St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands. The Buffaloes will play three games in four days against a field that includes Drake, Drexel, Houston, Liberty, Mercer, Quinnipiac, and Wake Forest.
