CONSECUTIVE FGS MADE: Then-sophomore Andre Roberson shot 66.7 percent during the Pac-12 Tournament (20-of-30). Roberson made 11 straight field goal attempts dating back to the game-winning put-back against Oregon in the quarterfinals. His streak tied for the third longest, and just one off the school record of 12 held by teammates House Guest and Shaun Vandiver one year apart. Roberson's 11-straight are the most on the road or at a neutral site. His 6-of-6 performance from the field against Cal, which included two 3-pointers, was a career-best percentage.

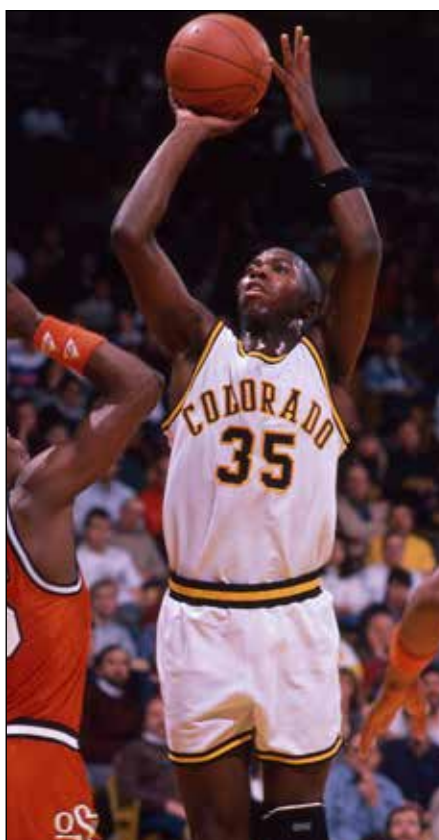

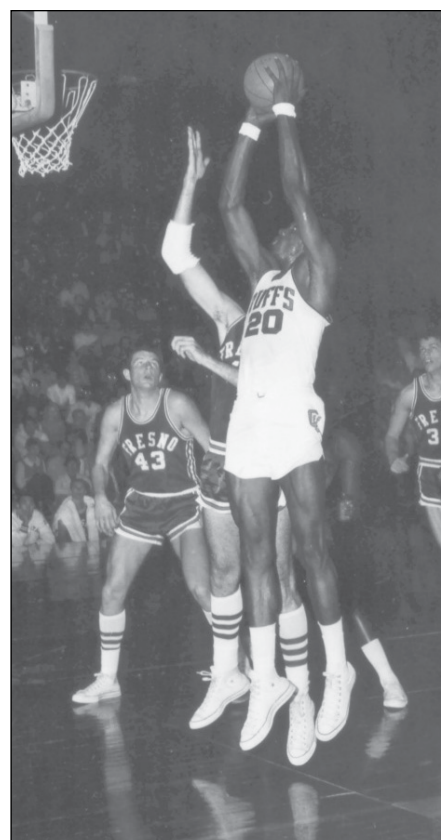

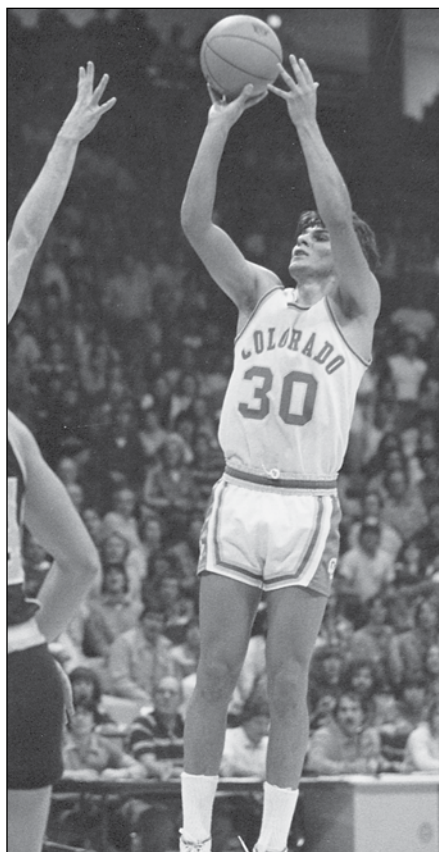

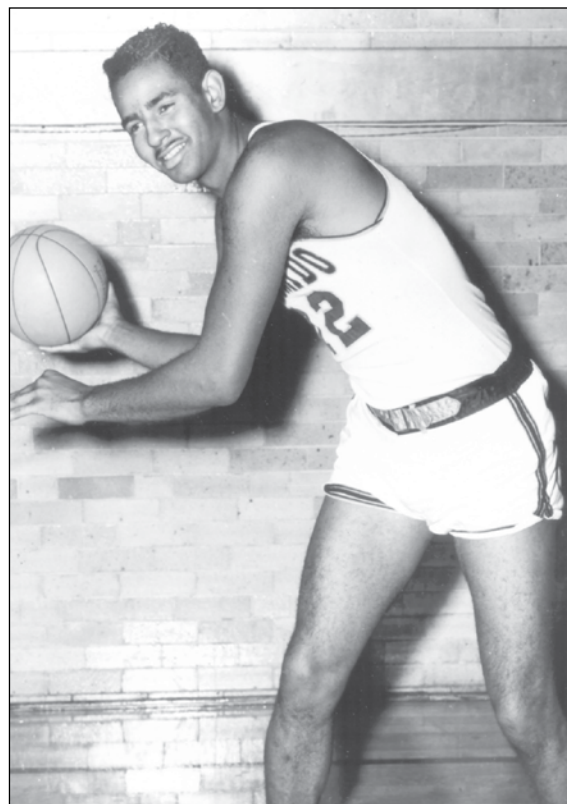

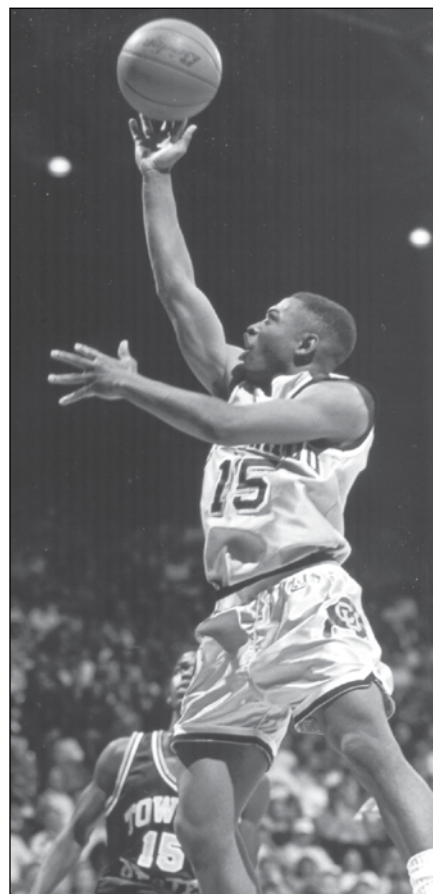
