

BUFFALO BITS / Colorado vs. Kansas

QUICKLY... The defending Big Eight champion Colorado Buffaloes (5-1-1, 2-0 Big 8) will try to take step three in repeating their title against the Kansas Jayhawks (1-4-1, 0-1-1)... Colorado has the second best record in college football since the start of the 1989 season, as the Buffs are 16-2-1 in that time frame (only Tennessee has a better mark, 15-1-2; CU's 16-1-1 regular season mark is the best in the NCAA since '89).

STREAKIN'... The Buffaloes have won 10 straight Big Eight Conference games (dating back to the 1988 finale), a new school best; the old mark was nine straight between 1960 and 1962. CU's all-time best victory streak in conference play is 13, between 1908 and 1911 (in two leagues, the Colorado Football Association and the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference), followed by 12 in a row in RMAC play between 1922 and 1924).

IN THE POLLS... This has to be a record, as CU has now fallen in the wire service polls three times after victories this year (Stanford, Missouri, Iowa State). Though the Buffs stayed No. 14 in the Associated Press polling, the Buffs went from 11th to 14th in the UPI (coaches) balloting.

COACH BILL McCARTNEY... Bill McCartney (Missouri '62) is in his ninth season at the reins of the CU football program, and will coach his 100th game today as the Buff mentor. He has compiled a 51-46-2 record through eight-plus campaigns. "Mac" is 44-21-1 over the last five-plus seasons, and is 37-12-1 since the start of the 1986 conference season. He has the most success in the Big Eight against Kansas, as the Buffaloes are 7-1 against the Jayhawks under his direction. "Mac" has been the Buff pilot for 99 games, topped only by Eddie Crowder (119), Dal Ward (110) and Fred Folsom (102). Those same three and Myron Witham are also the only ones ahead of McCartney in number of seasons coached (Folsom 15, Witham 12, Ward and Crowder 11 each) and in victories (Folsom 77, Crowder 67, Witham and Ward 63 each). In the Big Eight, Mac is 31-26-1 in conference games (27-10 since 1985), and is second only to Tom Osborne of Nebraska in longevity in the league.

BIENIEMY WATCH... Senior tailback Eric Bieniemy, who became CU's all-time leading rusher two weeks ago against Kansas, needs just 12 points to tie Bobby Anderson for the all-time school scoring record (212 points). "EB" has 3,178 career rushing yards, along with 16 100-yard rushing efforts, both school bests. He enters today's game as the nation's second leading rusher (144.3 yards per game).

Eric Bieniemy is first in the Big Eight and second in the nation in rushing (144.3 per game), and he also leads the conference in all-purpose yardage (168.5; he is sixth nationally). He is fourth in the league in total offense and is fifth in the Big Eight in scoring (8.0; that's 27th nationally). Tom Rouen is first in the league in punting (41.4), and is 22nd nationally. Tim James is third in the Big Eight in interceptions (four,.6 per game), and is tied for 25th nationally. Mike Pritchard is third in the league in all-purpose yardage (119.6), which is 45th in the NCAA. Dave McCloughan is first in the league in punt returns (14.2), which places him 13th in the country.

LAST WEEK IN REVIEW... The Buffaloes finally played a game that didn't come down to the final minutes, as Colorado's third quarter domination broke open a close game enroute to defeating Iowa State, 28-12. Iowa State scored on the first possession of the game, but the PAT was botched to leave the 'Clones up 6-0. A field goal which followed a Buff turnover made it 9-0 six minutes into the game, which proved to be CU's wakeup call. Charles Johnson hooked up with Michael Simmons for a 29-yard touchdown pass on the next drive to get the Buffs on the board. Colorado took its first lead of the game, 14-12, right before halftime on a three-yard touchdown pass from Darian Hagan to Sean Brown, and continued its momentum in the second half. Eric Bieniemy scored from a yard out and Mike Pritchard did the same on a 30-yard reverse in the third quarter in which CU outgained Iowa State 177-11 and possessed the ball for 11:45. The Cyclones never threatened after that point, even punting on third down once. Colorado's ball control offense ran 76 plays to 58 for ISU, and put a season-high 484 yards of total offense on the stat sheet (which included 362 rushing yards). **KEYS TO THE WIN---**1. CU Defense. The Buff defense suffocated Iowa State after the Cyclones first drive. I-State roared down the field in eight plays to open the game, an 80-yard drive which yielded the Cyclones lone touchdown of the day. After CU adjusted, Iowa State was limited to just 139 yards on 50 plays, 23 of which gained zero or minus yardage. 2. Darian Hagan. CU's junior quarterback came off the bench despite remnants from a sprained shoulder to lead CU to the win. Hagan completed seven passes for 69 yards and a touchdown, had a key 27-yard run on CU's last touchdown drive, and worked his usual magic in deceiving the opponent when it came to pitching the ball. 3. Mental Aspects. The Buffs broke Iowa State's confidence in two ways; first, CU used an 11-of-16 performance (third best in school history) on third down conversions. Second, Iowa State often stifled the Buffs on first down, but not often enough: CU had gains of 29, 14, 50 and 39 on first down plays to offset 12 which went for two yards or less.

STATS-N-FACTS... Since converting to the wishbone in 1985 (and moving to the Power-I in 1988 and the I-Bone in 1989), Colorado has posted the following records under certain circumstances. In that time, Colorado is 44-21-1 (0-4 in bowls); here's a look:

- 29-2-1 when rushing for 300 or more yards;
- 15-19 when held under 300 yards rushing; 3-11 when held under 200);
- 12-0 when rushing for 400 or more yards;
- 20-5 when passing for 100-plus yards (2-0 with 200-plus);
- 24-0-1 when amassing 400-plus yards total offense (10-0 with 500-plus);
- 12-0 when punting two or fewer times (17-4 with three or fewer);
- 24-0 when holding opponent to under 100 yards rushing;
- 26-5 when holding opponent under 300 yards total offense;
- 29-6 when scoring first (have won 23 of last 25);
- 23-2 when running more plays than the opponent;
- 34-2-1 when holding edge in time of possession (10-19 when not);
- 30-8 when committing two or fewer turnovers (9-1 with zero);
- 4-8-1 when committing four or more turnovers;
- 23-1 when converting over 50 percent on third down attempts;
- 24-2 when making 20-plus first downs;
- 34-6 when average field position is CU30 or better;
- 35-7 when holding opponents to 17 points or less (39-7 in Mac Era);
- 11-0 when two CU players rush for 100-plus yards.
